The grantee herein to maintain the said lines of poles where the same are now constructed over, and across the above described tracts of land.

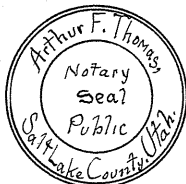

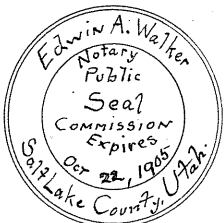
