WILFORD C. WOOD, Grantor, of Davis County, State of Utah, does hereby give and grant unto MOUNTAIN FUEL SUPPLY COMPANY, Grantee, a Utah corporation, of Salt Lake City, Utah, for the sum of TWO HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$200.00), receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, a right to use a right of way over a route heretofore designated by Grantor and agreed to by Grantee, to a pipeline construction project, upon and across the following described property, for vehicular, construction equipment and foot traffic of any and all kinds, to-wit:

The land of the Grantor in Davis County, Utah, more particularly described as the Camp Half of Section 1, Township 1 North, Range 1 West; and All of Section 6, Township 1 North, Range 1 East; and All of Section 7, Township 1 North, Range 1 East, Salt Lake Base and Meridian.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD unto said Mountain Fuel Supply Company for a period of one hundred and twenty (120) consecutive days from the date of this instrument, after which date this grant shall terminate and become null and void.

Grantee agrees to use said premises for access to a pipeline construction project, and Grantee and/or Grantee's contractor may freely use said route for said purposes; provided that Grantee shall widen the route where necessary for use by heavy trucks and grade where necessary so water will run down the side.

Grantee agrees to pay for or repair any damages caused by it during its use of the above right of way at the time such damage occurs, usual wear excepted. Grantor requests no work be done on Sabbath Day unless absolutely necessary. Grantor will accept the judgment of Grantee as to such work. This right of way shall not be assigned without consent of Grantor.


