Utah, containing one hundred sixty acres, according to the Official Plat of the Survey of the said lands, returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General, which said Tract has been purchased by the said Samuel A.Jenkins: NOW KNOW YE. That the United States of Arerica, in consideration of the premises, and in conformity with the several Acts of Congress in such case , made and provided, Have Given and Granted, and by these presents Do Give and Grant, unto the said Samuel A.Jenkins and to his heirs , the said Tract above described; TO MANYE AND TO HOLD; the same, together with all the rights, privileges, immunities, and appurtenances, of whatseever nature, thereunte belonging, unto the said Samuel A. Jenkins. and to his heirs and assigns forever; subject to any accrued water rights for agricultural canufacturing, or other purposes, and rights to ditches and reservoirs used in connection with such water rights, as may be recognized and acknowledged by the local customs , laws, and decisions of courts, and also subject to the right of the proprietor of a vein or lode to extract and remove his one therefrom, should the same by found to penetrate or intersect the premises he oby granted, as provided by law; and there is reserved from the lands hereby granted a rigit of way thereon for ditches or canals constructed by the authority of the United States.IN PESTIMONY WHELEOF, I, William H.
