Poulsen, a widow, Grantor, of Cache County, Utah, hereby conveys and warrants to UTAH POWER & LIGHT COMPANY, a corporation, its successors in interest and assigns, Grantee, for the sum of One (\$1.00) Dollar and other valuable consideration, a perpetual easement and right of way for the erection and continued maintenance, repair, alteration, and replacement of the electric transmission, distribution and telephone circuits of the Grantee, and 2 guy anchors - 2 poles, with the necessary guys, stubs, cross-arms and other attachments thereon, or affixed thereto, for the support of said circuits, to be erected and maintained upon and across the premises of the Grantor, in Cache County, Utah, along a line described as follows:

One pole and guy anchor located on grantor's land at a point 1075 feet north and 1975 feet east, more or less, and one pole and guy anchor located on said land at a point 1300 feet north and 625 feet east, more or less, from the southwest corner of Section 19, T. 12 N. R. 1 W. S.L.B. & M. and being in the S. 1/2 of the SW 1/4 of said Section 19.

Peterson his wife, Grantors, of Cache County, Utah, hereby convey and warrant to UTAH POWER & LIGHT COMPANY, a corporation, its successors in interest and assigns, Grantee, for the sum of One (\$1.00) Dollar and other valuable consideration, a perpetual easement and right of way for the erection and continued maintenance, repair, alteration, and replacement of the electric transmission, distribution and telephone circuits of the Grantee, and 1 guy anchor 10 poles, with the necessary guys, stubs cross-arms and other attachments thereon, or affixed thereto, for the support of said circuits, to be erected and maintained upon and across the premises of the Grantors, in Cache County, Utah, along a line described as follows:

Beginning on north boundary line of Grantor's land at south fence line of County road at a point 1360 feet south and 340 feet west, more or less, from the north quarter corner of Section 19, T. 12 N. R. 1 W., S.L.B. & M., thence running S. 6°21' W. 1279 feet, thence S. 7°47' W. 1347 feet, thence N. 89°27' W. 1370 feet, thence N. 64°31' W. 716 feet to fence on west boundary line of said land and being in the SE 1/4 of the NW 1/4 and the N 1/2 of the SW 1/4 of said Section 19.

Excepting from above that part of line on or over State Highway, Route No. 69.
