

LIBERTY FUEL COMPANY, a corporation doing business in the State of Utah, hereby conveys and warrants to UTAH POWER & LIGHT COMPANY, a corporation, its successors in interest and assigns, Grantee, for the sum of One (\$1.00) Dollar and other valuable consideration, a perpetual easement and right of way for the erection and continued maintenance, repair, alteration, and replacement of the electric transmission, distribution and telephone circuits of the Grantee, and 7 guys and 19 poles, with the necessary guys, stubs, cross-arms and other attachments, thereon, or affixed thereto, for the support of said circuits, to be erected and maintained upon and across the premises of the Grantor, in Carbon County, Utah, along a line described as follows:

Beginning on north bndy line of grantor's land at a point 2640 ft. north and 1150 ft. west, more or less, from the southeast corner of Sec. 7, T. 13 S. R. 9 East, S.L.B.&M., th. Running S. 8°47' E. 100 ft. more or less to angle pole, th. s. 0°11' E. 669 ft., th. S. 33°09' E. 346 ft., th. S 61°58' E. 490 ft., th. S. 36°29' E 556 ft., th. S. 56°24' E 880 ft., th. S. 73°07' E. 715 ft. more or less, to east bndy line of said land and being in the E½ of the SE¼ said Sec. 7, and the SW¼ of the SW¼ Sec. 8, Twp. and Range aforesaid.

Together with all rights of ingress and egress necessary or convenient for the full and complete use, occupation and enjoyment of the easement hereby granted, and all rights and privileges incident thereto, including the right to cut and remove timber, trees, brush, overhanging branches and other obstructions which may injure or interfere with the Grantee's use, occupation or enjoyment of this easement.
