POLE LINE EASEMENT

TRANS-WESTERN MACHINERY COMPANY, a Colorado corporation, GRANTOR, hereby quitclaims to UTAH POWER & LIGHT COMPANY, a corporation, its successors in interest and assigns, GRANTEE, for the sum of ONE DOLLAR (\$1.00) and other valuable consideration, a perpetual easement and right of way for the erection and continued maintenance, repair, alteration and replacement of the electric transmission, distribution and telephone circuits of the GRANTEE, and four guy anchors and two poles, with the necessary guys, stubs, cross-arms and other attachments thereon or affixed thereto for the support of said circuits, to be erected and maintained upon and across the premises of the GRANTOR in Salt Lake County, State of Utah, along a line described as follows:
