Newman, A. Battisson, John R. Thorn, Robert Dansie, Alfred H. Dewey, J. Malquist, and Henry Brown, and personally knows that said Reuben S. Hamilton, K. Larsen, Joseph Nattress, Aron Holmberg, William Biggs, Geo. Hackett, R. S. Hamilton, Edward Orgill, W. J. Charles, Wm. Newman, A. Battisson, John R. Thorn, Robert Dansie, Alfred H. Dewey, J. Malquist, and Henry Brown, all now deceased, were the signers of that certain agreement dated at Riverton, Utah, December 17, 1900, establishing a ditch right-of-way through the property of said Reuben S. Hamilton for the users of the Floom Ditch, which said agreement is attached hereto and made a part hereof; and further personally knows that said Reuben S. Hamilton and said R. S.
