And Whereas, the said Frank Prince has paid for said lands, pursuant to the conditions of said sale, and the laws of the State duly enacted in relation thereto the sum of Two Hundred (\$200.00) Dollars, and all legal interest thereon accrued as fully appears by the certificate of the proper office, now on file in the office of the Secretary of State of the State of Utah:

Now Therefore, I, William Spry, Governor, in consideration of the premises, and by virtue of the power and authority vested in me by the laws of the State of Utah, in such case made and provided, do issue this patent, in the name and by the authority of the State of Utah, hereby granting and confirming unto the said Frank Prince and to his heirs and assigns forever, the following piece or parcel of land, situated in the County of Iron State aforesaid, to wit:


