The National Equipment Company, a corporation doing business in the State of Utah, Grantor, hereby conveys and warrants to UTAH POWER & LIGHT COMPANY, a corporation, its successors in interest and assigns and licensees, Grantee, for the sum of One (\$1.00) Dollar and other valuable consideration, a perpetual easement and right of way for the erection and continued maintenance, repair, alteration, and replacement of the electric transmission, distribution, and telephone circuits of the Grantee, and no guy anchors and one pole poles, with the necessary guys, stubs, crossarms and other attachments thereon, or affixed thereto, for the support of said circuits, to be erected and maintained on, under, upon and across the premises of the Grantor, in Salt Lake County, Utah along a line described as follows:

**Beginning at the east boundary line of the Grantor's land at a point 115 feet north, more or less, from the southeast corner of Lot 15, Block 8, Five Acre Plat "B", Big Field Survey, thence West 29 feet on said land and being in said Lot 15.**

Together with all rights of ingress and egress necessary or convenient for the full and complete use, occupation and enjoyment of the easement hereby granted, and all rights and privileges incident thereto, including the right to cut and remove timber, trees, brush, overhanging branches and other obstructions which may injure or interfere with the Grantee's use, occupation or enjoyment of this easement.
