My dear Mr. Phillips:

I have received your communication of December 29, 1946, in reply to my inquiry of November 27, 1946.

In view of the fact that the enclosed watering place is used exclusively by you on your privately-owned lands, in view of the fact that you have exclusive right to this spring, and that it appears desirable to improve the fencing around this spring for the protection of livestock, it is my opinion that you have the right to proceed to repair this fencing or protect the spring in such manner as you see fit without any formal permit.

There, therefore, appears to be no objection to your proceeding, at your convenience, with such improvements in the fencing as you desire to make.
