## ABSTRACT OF FINDINGS AND ORDER

I, Mildred G. Snider, being first duly sworn, depose and say that I am the Secretary of the Salt Lake City Board of Adjustment, and that on the 14th day of July, 1969, Case No. 5779 by Eleanor O'Brien Dahnken was heard by the Board. 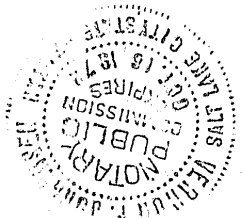
