of land, situate in the County of Washington State aforesaid, to-wit:

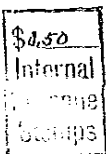
The South West quarter (SW $\frac{1}{4}$) of the South West quarter (SW $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section

certificate.

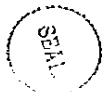
To Have and To Hold the above described and granted premises unto the said
