The South Half (S- $\frac{1}{2}$) of the South east quarter (SE- $\frac{1}{4}$); the South Half (S- $\frac{1}{2}$) of the Southwest quarter (SW- $\frac{1}{4}$) and the North Half (N- $\frac{1}{2}$) of the Southeast quarter (SE- $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section Twenty-four (24); And all of Section Twenty-five (25) in Township Two (2) South, Range Five (5) East and Lots Two (2) and Three (3) and the Southeast quarter (SE- $\frac{1}{4}$) of the Northwest quarter (NW- $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section Thirty (30) in Township Two (2) South Range Six East of the Salt Lake Meridian, containing Nine Hundred and Ninety Nine and 40/100 acres according to the said certificate.
