

# DIETER JOHNSON Main Street Addition

Being all of Lot 17 and East half of Lot 5  
in Block 11 in FIVE ACRE PLAT "A"  
BIG FIELD SURVEY

## CERTIFICATE OF SURVEYOR.

I hereby certify that the tract of  
Land shown on this diagram and  
known as Dieter and Johnson's Main St. Addn.  
is bounded and described as follows,  
to wit:

Commencing at a point four  
rods (4) East, and sixty five (65) rods  
South, from N.W. Cor. of Lot 1, Sec 18,  
Tp. 1 S., R. 1 E., S. 1 M., thence East forty  
rods (40) to West side of State, or  
Territorial road. Thence South seven-  
teen and four tenths (17.4) rods; thence  
West sixty seven (67) rods; thence South  
seventeen and four tenths (17.4) rods;  
thence East twenty three (23) rods; thence  
North thirty four and eight tenths  
(34.8) rods, to point of beginning. Containing  
an area of seven and twenty eight  
one hundredths acres and is known  
as Lot 17 and East half of Lot 5 in  
Block Eleven, in Five Acre Plat "A"  
Big Field Survey. And that I have  
by request and authority of the said  
owners thereof, subdivided the same  
into lots, streets, avenues, and alleys,  
to be known as Dieter and Johnson's  
Main St. Addition, and that the  
same has been correctly staked out

on the ground as represented hereon.  
The following are the names and  
dimensions of parcels designated  
for public use, to wit: **FREMONT AVENUE**,  
fifteen feet wide, and Two hundred  
and eighty seven and one tenth (287.1)  
feet long running North and South being  
**MAIN STREET**, sixty six feet wide and  
five hundred and seventy four and  
two tenths (574.2) long, North and South;  
**MAJOR AVENUE**, eighty two and five  
tenths (82.5) feet wide, and Two hundred  
and eighty seven and one tenth  
287.1 feet North and South.  
**ARMSTRONG AVENUE** - thirty three feet  
wide, and eleven hundred and  
five and five tenths (1105.5) feet, East  
and west, being 1/2 of St.  
Lots numbered 1 & 2 in Block 3  
are twenty nine and one tenth (29.1)  
ft. wide and one hundred and  
forty one (41) ft. long all other lots in  
Block 3 are twenty five feet (25) wide  
and one hundred and forty one  
(41) feet long. Lots No. 1 & 2 in Blocks  
No. 1 & 2 are twenty nine and one  
tenth (29.1) feet wide, and one hundred  
and thirty six and one hundred and  
twenty five one thousandths (136.125)  
long, all other lots in Blocks No. 1 & 2  
are twenty five (25) wide, and one  
hundred and thirty six and one  
hundred and twenty five one thousa-  
ndths (136.125) feet long. Alleys are  
sixteen and five tenths (16.5) feet  
wide.

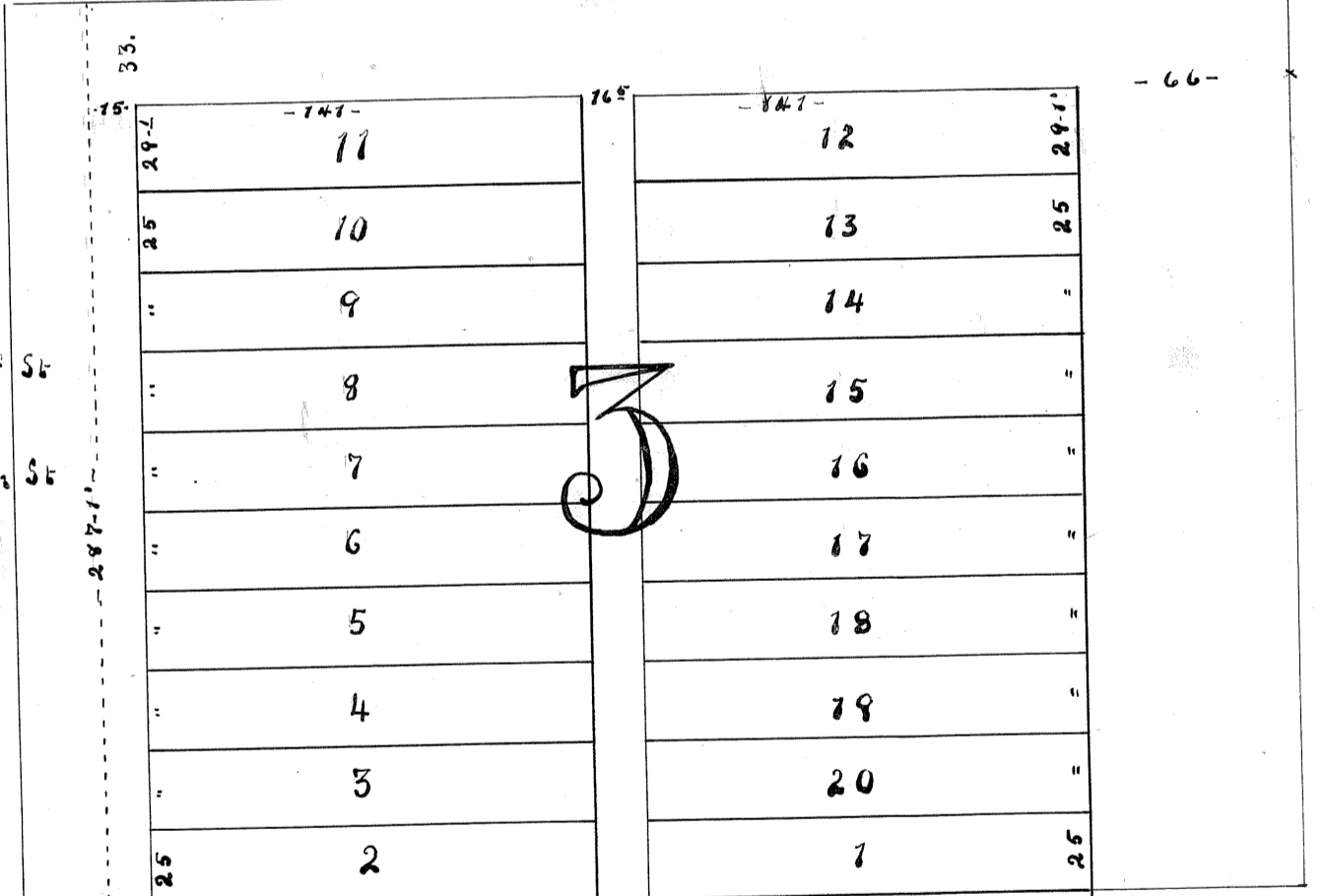
## MAIN STREET ADDITION
