

Whereas, James E. Anderson of Cedar City of the County of Iron State of Utah heretofore purchased from the State of Utah, the lands hereinafter described, pursuant to the laws of said State in such case made and provided, And Whereas, the said James E. Anderson has paid for said lands, pursuant to the conditions of said sale, and the laws of the State duly enacted in relation thereto, the sum of One Thousand Five Hundred seventy five and 45/100 (\$1575.45) Dollars, and all legal interest thereon accrued, as fully appears by the certificate of the proper officer, now on file in the office of the Secretary of State of the State of Utah:

Now Therefore, I Charles R. Mabey, Governor, in consideration of the premises, and by the virtue of the power and authority vested in me by the laws of the State of Utah, hereby granting and confirming unto the said James E. Anderson and to his heirs and assigns, forever the following piece or parcel of land, situate in the County of Washington State aforesaid, to wit: All of Section Thirty-Two (32) in Township Forty (40) South, Range Thirteen (13) West of the Salt Lake Meridian, containing Six Hundred Thirty and 18/100 (630.18) acres according to the said certificate.
