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ABSTRACT OF FINDINGS AND ORDER

I, Mildred G. Snider, being first duly sworn, depose and say that I am the Secretary of the Salt Lake City Board of Adjustment, and that on the 18th day of December, 1973, <u>Case No. 6410</u> by Robert Blakes and Clemence G. Martin was heard by the Board. The applicants requested a variance on the property at 751 West North Temple Street to construct a mortuary which would be a conditional use in a Commercial "C-1" District and which requires Board of Adjustment approval, the legal description of said property being as follows:

Commencing at the Northeast corner of Lot 6, Block 59, Plat "C", Salt Lake City Survey and running thence South 20 rods; thence West 7 rods; thence North 5 rods; thence West 3 rods; thence North 9 rods; thence West 4 rods; thence North 6 rods; thence East 14 rods to the point of beginning.

It was moved, seconded and unanimously passed that a variance be granted to permit as a conditional use this proposed mortuary in accordance with the plan filed with the case and with the following provisions:

- that the setbacks on the parking area be defined by 6" poured concrete control curbs
- 2. that the back portion of the property also be devoted to parking
- that both parking areas be drained and hardsurfaced to meet all requirements of the City Engineer's office
- 4. that the setbacks be completely landscaped and that sprinkling systems be installed to insure proper maintenance
- 5. that the driveways be subject to approval by the Traffic Engineer and the State Road Commission.
