

WATER RIGHT

CONVEYANCE OF PROPERTY AND EASEMENT

The Middle Canyon Irrigation Company of Tooele County, Utah, Grantor, does hereby convey and warrant to the Utah Water and Power Board, Grantee, for good and valuable consideration, receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, the following right to the use of water.

All interest which the Middle Irrigation Company has to the water of Middle Canyon as stated in the Decree of Judge Morse dated 21st of May, 1914, Tooele County, Utah, or to any or all of the water rights which have since been transferred to Middle Canyon Irrigation Company by any or all of the parties named as plaintiffs in the aforesaid decree.

The above Grantors do also grant to the Utah Water and Power Board an easement to the full use of the irrigation distribution and collection system of the Middle Canyon Irrigation Company by which the water of the above decree is collected and put to beneficial use. The distribution and collection systems lie in the following sections in Tooele County, Utah:

Sections 2, 11, 13, 14, 21, 22, 23, 26, 27, 28, 35, 36 T3S R4W SLB & M.
Sections 1, T4S R4W SLB & M, and Sections 5, 6, 8 and 9, T4S R3W SLB & M.
And Special Sections 37 & 38, T4S R3W SLB & M.
