




BENWOOD SUBDIVISION

I hereby certify that the tract of land shown on his map and owned by BEN R. ELDREDGE and LIZZIE S. ELDREDGE his wife is bounded and described as follows: Beginning at the south-east corner of Lot one, of Block thirty-five, Ten acre Plat A. Big field Survey, hence running north eleven hundred and forty-eight and four tenths (1148.4) feet; Thence west seven hundred and fifty nine (759) feet; Thence south five hundred and seventy-four and two tenths (574.2) feet; Thence east three hundred and seventy-nine and five tenths (379.5) feet; Thence west one hundred and seventy-nine and five tenths (179.5) feet; to the place of beginning. Containing fifteen (15) acres, and known as Lot sixteen and the east half of Lot one in block thirty-five, Ten acre Plat A. Big field Survey, that I have by authority of the said owners herein subdivided the same into lots, avenues and alleys to be known as BENWOOD SUBDIVISION. That the same has been correctly staked out on the ground as represented heron, and that the steel tape used in making the survey hereof was of correct length.

DIMENSIONS OF LOTS.

Lots one to twenty-two inclusive in block one (1) and lots two to twenty-one inclusive in block two are forty-nine and five tenths (49.5) feet by one hundred and forty-eight and four tenths (148.4) feet; lots one and twenty-two in block two are forty-two and nine tenths (42.9) feet by one hundred and forty-eight and five tenths (48.5) feet;
