

BOARD OF CANVASSERS

The Board of Weber County Commissioners met on Monday, December 24, 1956 at 12:00 noon in the session room of the County Commissioners in the City & County Building, as a Board of Canvassers.

Chairman Carver presided.

Mr. Malan, County Clerk, informed the Board that returns had been received from the Warren and West Warren Districts in Weber County, of the election held on Monday, December 21, 1956, for the organization of the Warren-West Warren Cemetery Maintenance District.

Mr. Malan produced before the Board the returns received by him from the Judges of Election in and for the district as required by Chapter 1, Title 8, Section 3-1-7, Utah Code Annotated, 1953, and stated that he had checked the registration books for said District and there are 239 registered voters.

The Board proceeded to canvass the votes cast at the election.

The Canvass of the returns having been completed, it is hereby unanimously declared that the following is a full, true and correct statement as to the election:

A map showing the boundary of the Warren-West Warren Cemetery Maintenance District was presented to the Board of County Commissioners of Weber County. Which said map is marked Exhibit "A" and is attached hereto and is made a part hereof by reference and the boundaries of said District are established as they are on the said Exhibit "A" shown.

WHEREUPON, on motion of Commissioner Hess it was unanimously ordered that as it appears from the canvass that more than one-half of all the qualified voters in said District who have paid a property tax in such District in the year next preceding the election, have voted in favor of the organization of the Warren-West Warren Cemetery Maintenance District, covering the hereinafter described territory and that said territory District be divided into three parts to be known as and as shown on said Exhibit "A" as Districts 1, 42 and 43 and the boundaries of said sub-districts are hereby established by reference to said Exhibit "A", and that the following be recommended to the Governor of the State of Utah, as the first "comes on" of said

Beginning at a point on the Boundary Line between Box Elder and Weber Counties, which point is North 288.7 feet from the north quarter corner of Section 19, Township 7 North, Range 2 West and running thence South through the centers of Sections 19, 30 and 31, Township 7 North, Range 2 West, to a point in the North $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 6, Township 6 North, Range 2 West; said point being on the boundary between Plain City and Warren Districts; said point being 1.33 feet South of the point being 2,640 feet West from the NE corner of Section 6, thence East to the Section Line between Sections 5 and 6, thence South along the Section Line between Sections 5 and 6, Township 6 North, Range 2 West, to the corner common to Sections 5, 6, 7 and 8; thence east along the Section Line between Sections 5 and 8 to the center of Weber River; thence southerly along the center of Weber River to a point on the South line of Section 31, Township 6 North, Range 2 West and the north line of Section 32, Township 6 North, Range 2 West; thence West along said Township line to the East shore of the Great Salt Lake; thence Northerly along the meanderings of said Lake and Willard Bay to the Boundary Line between Box Elder and Weber Counties; thence East along said boundary to the place of beginning.
