

EASEMENT TO USE DISTRIBUTION SYSTEM

BLACK CANYON IRRIGATION COMPANY, a corporation of the County of Washington, State of Utah, GRANTOR, for the sum of TEN DOLLARS (\$10.00) and other good and valuable consideration, receipt of which is hereby acknowledged and for the consideration of an agreement dated January 6, 1924, with the State of Utah, acting through the BOARD OF WATER RESOURCES, GRANTEE, for the construction of a diversion dam and transmission pipeline, does hereby grant and assign to the State of Utah, acting through the BOARD OF WATER RESOURCES, an easement to use the existing water distribution system of canals, ditches, pipelines and all appurtenant works and facilities of the BLACK CANYON IRRIGATION COMPANY in Section 14, 23, 26, and 27 of T37S, R17W, SLB&M, South of Enterprise in Washington County, Utah.


