WARRANTY DEED

Jones and Edith Jones his wife Grantors, of Henefer, County of Summit, State of Utah, hereby convey and warrant to Summit County, a municipal Corporation, Grantee, of the State of Utah; for the sum of TWENTY DOLLARS the following described tract of land in Summit County, State of Utah, to-wit:

Situate in the N. E. $\frac{1}{4}$ of the N. W. $\frac{1}{4}$ and the West Half of the N. E. $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 32, Township 4 North, Range 4 east Salt Lake Meridian. Beginning at a point which is North 32° 06' W. 3,961.5 feet from the S. E. Corner of Section 32, Twp 4 North, Range 4 east, Salt Lake Meridian and running thence S. 68° 00' W. 35 ft; thence North 25° 38' West 684.7 feet, thence N. 47° 48' West, 2,012 ft, thence N. 68° 00' East 66 feet, thence S. 47° 48' East 2,012 ft. thence S. 25° 38' East 684.7 ft; thence S. 68° 00' W. 35 ft to the point of beginning and containing 4.085 acres more or less.

TO ALL WHOM THESE PRESENTS SHALL COME GREETING:

WHEREAS, David B. Brinton of Murray, of the County of Salt Lake, State of Utah, heretofore purchased from the State of Utah, the lands hereinafter described, pursuant to the laws of said State in such case made and provided,

AND WHEREAS, the said David B. Brinton has paid for said lands, pursuant to the conditions of said sale, and the laws of the State duly enacted in relation thereto, the sum of Seven Hundred and Forty Eight (\$748.00) Dollars, and all legal interest thereon accrued as fully appears by the certificate of the proper officer, now on file in the office of the Secretary of State of the State of Utah;

NOW, WHEREFORE, I WILLIAM SPRY, GOVERNOR, in consideration of the premises, and by virtue of the power and authority vested in me by the laws of the State of Utah, in such case made and provided, do issue this PATENT, in the name and by the authority of the State of Utah, hereby granting and confirming unto the said David B. Brinton and to his heirs and assigns forever, the following piece or parcel of land, situate in the County of Summit, State aforesaid, to-wit:

The "ast Half (E-1/2); the South Half (S-1/2) of the North West Quarter (NW-1/4) and the South West quarter (SW-1/4) of Section Thirty Six (36) in Township One (1) North Range Seven (7) East of the Salt Lake Meridian,

containing Five Hundred and Sixty (560) acres according to the said certificate TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the above described and granted premises unto the said David B. Brinton and to his heirs and assigns forever, subject to any easement or right of way of the public, to use all such highways as may have been established according to law, over the same or any part thereof and subject also to all rights of way for ditches, tunnels, and telephone and transmission lines that may have been constructed by authority of the United States.

IN TESTIMONY WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the great seal of the State of Utah to be hereunto affixed.

DONE at Salt Lake City, this fifteenth day of January in the year of our Lord, one thousand nine hundred and thirteen, and of the independence of the United States of America the one hundred and thirty-seventh, and in the eighteenth year of the State of Utah.
