1. A right-of-way thereon for ditches and canals constructed by the authority of the United States. Act of August 30, 1890 (26 Stat. 391; 43 U.S.C. 945 (1970)).

2. All minerals in the lands above described, with the right to prospect for, mine and remove the same under applicable law and such regulations as the Secretary may prescribe. Act of October 21, 1976 (90 Stat. 2757; 43 U.S.C. 1719).


