ABSTRACT OF FINDINGS AND ORDER

I, Mildred G. Snider, being first duly sworn, depose and say that I am the Secretary of the Salt Lake City Board of Adjustment, and that on the 7th day of June, 1976, Case No. 7174 by Sugarhouse Park Authority, Mrs. Robert G. Blake, agent, was heard by the Board. The applicant requested a variance on property at 1620 East 21st South Street to erect a sign which would exceed the permitted area allowed contrary to the provisions of the Zoning Ordinance in a Residential "R-2" District, the legal description of said property being as follows:

A part of the Sugarhouse Park Authority located in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 21, T1S, R1E, SLB&M.

It was moved, seconded and passed by a three to two vote that a variance be granted to permit the proposed 2' x 20' roof sign (to be treated as an identification sign) with 8" movable letters, provided there is no illumination of the sign.
