POLE LINE EASEMENT

Hardy Salt Company

... a corporation doing business in the State of Utah, Grantor, hereby conveys and warrants to UTAH POWER & LIGHT COMPANY, a corporation, its successors in interest and assigns and licensees, Grantee, for the sum of One (\$1.00) Dollar and other valuable consideration, a perpetual easement and right of way for the erection and continued maintenance, repair, alteration, and replacement of the electric transmission, distribution, and telephone circuits of the Grantee, and 3 guy anchors, 2 two-pole structures and 9 poles, with the necessary guys, stubs, crossarms and other attachments thereon, or affixed thereto, for the support of said circuits, to be erected and maintained on, under, upon and across the premises of the Grantor, in Tooele County, Utah along a line described as follows:

Beginning on the east boundary fence of the Grantor's land at a point 650 feet north and 1860 feet west, more or less, from the east one quarter corner of Section 35, T. 1 S., R. 4 W., S.L.M., thence N. 82° 44' W. 1398 feet, thence S. 64° 14' W. 768 feet, thence S. 62° 38' W. 1971 feet on said land and being in Lots 2 and 3 and the NW 1/4 of the SW 1/4 of said Section 35, and Lot 1 of Section 34, Township and Range aforesaid.
