TO ALL TO WHOM THESE PRESENTS SHALL COME, GREETING:

WHEREAS, There has been deposited in the GENERAL LAND OFFICE of the United States a Certificate of the Register of the Land Office at Salt Lake City, Utah Territory, whereby it appears that, pursuant to the Act of Congress approved 20th May 1862, "To secure Homesteads to Actual Settlers on the Public Domain," and the acts supplemental thereto, the claim of Thomas S. Terry has been established and duly consummated in conformity to law, for the South half of the south east quarter of section thirty-one in township thirty-six south of range eighteen and lot numbered four of section five, and the lot numbered one of section six in township thirty seven south of range eighteen west of Salt Lake Meridian in Utah Territory, containing one hundred and sixty acres, according to the Official Plat of the Survey of the said Land returned to the GENERAL LAND OFFICE by the Surveyor General;

NOW KNOW YE, That there is, therefore, granted by the UNITED STATES unto the said Thomas S. Terry the tract of Land above described; TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said tract of Land, with the appurtenances thereof, unto the said Thomas S. Terry and to his heirs and assigns forever; subject to any vested and accrued water rights, for mining, agricultural, manufacturing, or other purposes, and rights to ditches and reservoirs used in connection with such water rights, as may have been recognized and acknowledged by the local customs, laws and decisions of courts, and also subject to the right of the proprietor of a vein or lode to extract and remove his ore therefrom, should the same be found to penetrate or intersect the premises hereby granted, as provided by law.

TO ALL TOWHOM THESE PRESENTS SHALL COME, GREETING:

WHEREAS, N. DONALD FORSYTH and FRANK KNEEL of Pinto of the County of Washington State of Utah here-to fore purchased from the State of Utah, the lands hereinafter described, pursuant to the laws of said State in such case made and provided,

AND WHEREAS, the said N. DONALD FORSYTH and FRANK KNEEL have paid for said lands, pursuant to the conditions of said sale and the laws of the State duly enacted in relation thereto, the sum of Two Hundred (\$200.00) Dollars, and all legal interest thereon accrued, as fully appears by the certificate of the proper officer, now on file in the office of the Secretary of State of the State of Utah.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, WILLIAM SPRY, Governor, in consideration of the premises, and by virtue of the power and authority vested in me by the laws of the State of Utah, in such case made and provided, do issue this Patent, in the name and by the authority of the State of Utah, hereby granting and confirming unto the said N. DONALD ^{Forsyth} and FRANK KNEEL and to their heirs and assigns forever, the following piece or parcel of land, situate in the County of Iron, State aforesaid, to-wit: East Half (E 1/2) of the Southwest quarter (SW 1/4) and the East Half (E 1/2) of the North West Quarter (NW 1/4) of Section Nine (9) Township Thirty-six (36) South, Range Fifteen (15) West of the Salt Lake Meridian, containing One Hundred and Sixty acres according to the said certificate.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the above described and granted premises unto the said N. DONALD FORSYTH and FRANK KNEEL and to their heirs and assigns forever, subject to any easement or right of way of the public, to use all such highways as may have been established according to law, over the same or any part thereof and subject also to all rights of way for ditches, tunnels and telephone and transmission lines that may have been constructed by the authority of the United States.
