RIGHT OF WAY EASEMENT

Jens Monson a Widower, of Utah County, State of Utah, Grantors, for One Dollar and other valuable considerations paid by Utah Power Company, a Maine Corporation, Grantee, receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, hereby grants, bargains, sells, and conveys to said Utah Power Company, its successors and assigns, an easement and right of way, and the right, privilege and authority to construct, erect, operate and maintain, a line or lines for the purpose of transmitting electric or other power, and telegraph and telephone lines, in, upon, along, over, through, across and under a piece of land 16 feet in width, situated in the County of Utah, and State of Utah, more particularly described as follows, to-wit:

Eight (8) feet on each side of a line as may be constructed, approximately along and over the following described course.

Beginning at a point about 2610 feet West from the center of Sec. 5 Tp. 5 S.R. 2 E. S.L.B. & M. and running thence S.0° 49' East a distance of 2480 feet and further described as following the course of the pole line of the Utah Power Company as now surveyed and located over said land.

Together with the rights to grantee, its successors and assigns, to place, erect, relocate, inspect and operate thereon poles, crossarms and fixtures, and to place and maintain such other appurtenances, useful or necessary to operate said line or lines, and string wires and cables, from time to time, across, through, under or over the above described premises; (however, as to the number of poles to be placed upon said land hereunder, it is understood and agreed that only Eight poles shall be placed upon said land under this easement for the above consideration; but if at any time the grantee shall desire to erect and
