ORDINANCE NO. 93-2

AN ORDINANCE DEFINING STREET WIDTHS WITHIN THE DUCHESNE CITY LIMITS.

WHEREAS, THE PURPOSE OF SAID ORDINANCE IS TO ESTABLISH A UNIFORM ROAD WIDTH WHENEVER POSSIBLE, WITHIN THE CITY LIMITS. ROAD WIDTHS RUNNING NORTH AND SOUTH, IN MOST CASES, WILL BE SIXTY (60) FEET. ROAD WIDTHS RUNNING EAST AND WEST, IN MOST CASES, WILL BE EIGHTY (80) FEET.

All road widths are defined on the attached set of plat maps and recorded at the Duchesne County Recorder's Office, after ratification and consent by the Duchesne City Council and the Duchesne City Planning and Zoning Board.

This ordinance will allow property owners to claim that footage which is shown as changed on the enclosed maps. In most cases, the amount of property released to the property owners will be ten (10) feet.

This ordinance was passed after public hearings by the City Council and Planning and Zoning Board on October 22, 1992. The changes are shown in detail at the City Office in addition to the Recorder's Office at the Duchesne County Courthouse.
