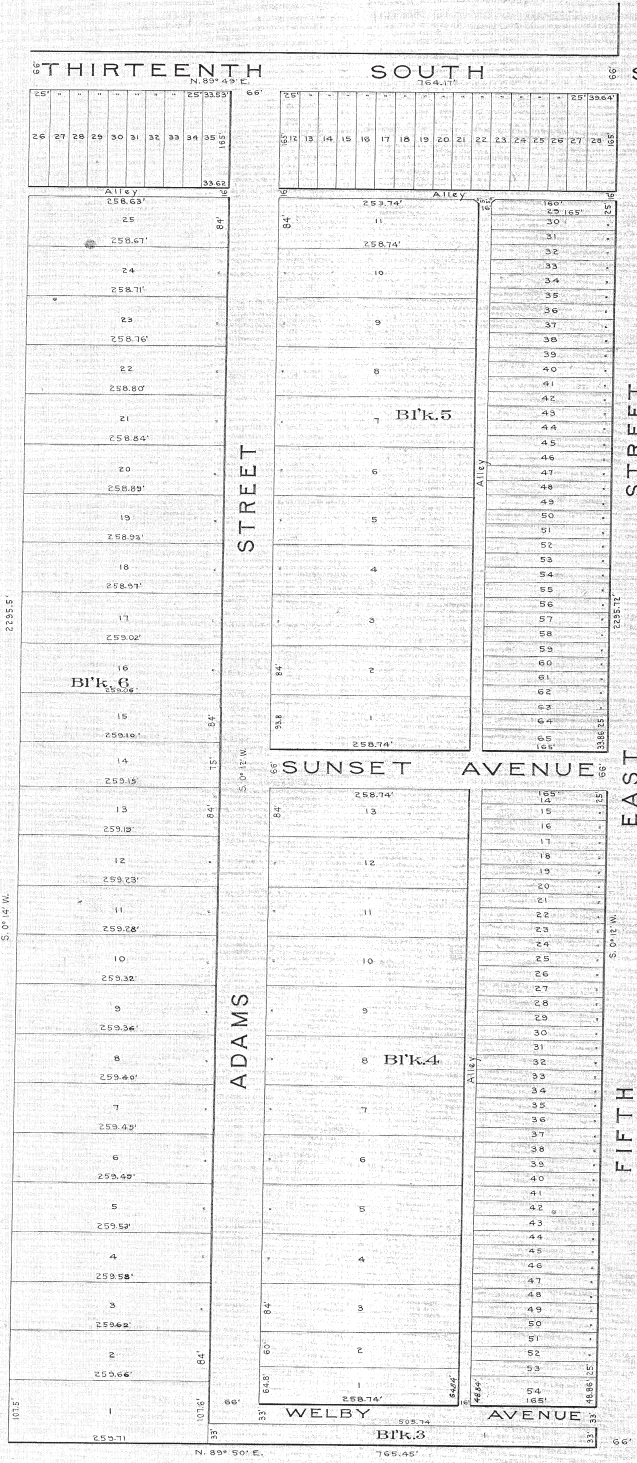

**SURVEYOR'S CERTIFICATE**  
I hereby certify that the tract of land shown on this map and owned by Charles F. Adams 2<sup>nd</sup> and Frances L. Adams, his wife, is described as follows: Being all of Lots 10, 11, 12 and 13, Block 31 and Lot 6, Block 30, Ten Acre Plot A, Big Field Survey; that I have by Authority of the said owners, thereto, subdivided the same into lots, streets, avenues and alleys, to be known as "Homefield". That the same has been correctly surveyed and established on the ground by the placing of 5.5x2.75x3 Concrete Monuments at the Block Corners and that the steel tape used in making the survey thereof was of correct length.

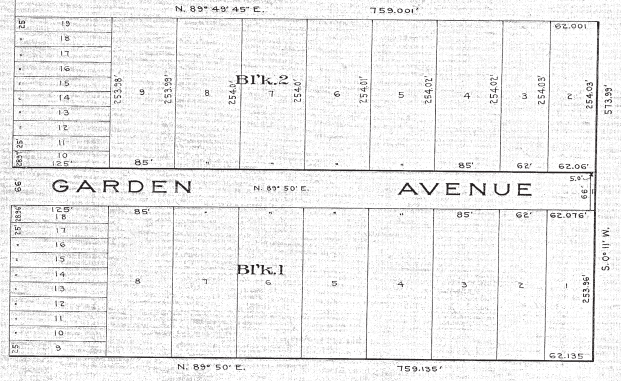
