3074625 CLARIFICATION OF PIPE LINE EASEMENT

MOUNT OLYMPUS DEVELOPMENT CORP. and ALEXANDER BUILDING CORP. granted SALT LAKE CITY SUBURBAN SANITARY DISTRICT NO. 1 a pipe line right-of-way easement September 27, 1956. The purpose of this statement is to more clearly describe the location of the right-of-way and the pipe main therein. The center of the pipe line right-of-way, which is sufficient for ingress and egress and to maintain and operate said pipe line in Salt Lake County, State of Utah, is as follows:

Beginning on the Southwestern boundary line of Lot 122 in Mount Olympus Acres Subdivision at a point North 68° West 4 ft. from the Northeast corner of Lot 115 of said Subdivision; and running thence North 22° East 65 ft. to a manhole (Station 2 + 50), thence North 14° 43' West 255 ft. to a manhole, thence North 16° 37' East 178 ft. to a manhole.

ALSO, beginning at said manhole station 2 + 50, as described above, and running thence North 54° 25' East 5 ft. to the East boundary line of said Lot 122 in Mount Olympus Acres Subdivision.

Attached hereto and made a part hereof is a small drawing showing the location of said easement and pipe line therein.
