Leigh has been established and duly consummated in conformity to law, for the South West quarter of the South West quarter of Section fifteen and the East half of the North West quarter and the North West quarter of the North West quarter of Section twenty two in Township thirty-five South of Range eleven West of Salt Lake Meridian in Utah, containing one hundred and sixty acres according to the Official Plat of the Survey of the said Land, returned to the GENERAL LAND OFFICE by the Surveyor General;
