Commencing on southwesterly boundary of Grantor's land at a point 885 feet south and 50 feet west of North $\frac{1}{4}$ corner Sec. 24, Tp. 1 S. R. 5 E., S.L.M., thence running S. 78°00' E. 495 feet to eastern boundary of same.

Together with all rights of ingress and egress necessary or convenient for the full and complete use, occupation and enjoyment of the easement hereby granted, and all rights and privileges incident thereto, including the right to cut and remove timber, trees, brush, overhanging branches and other obstructions which may injure or interfere with the Grantee's use, occupation or enjoyment of this easement.

Commencing on west boundary of Grantor's land at a point 605 feet south and 1465 feet east of N.W. corner Sec. 24, Tp. 1 S., R. 5 E., S. L. M., thence running N. 83°23' E., 50 feet, thence S. 78°00' E. 1185 feet to easterly boundary of same.
