ABSTRACT OF FINDINGS AND ORDER

I, Mildred G. Snider, being first duly sworn, depose and say that I am the Secretary of the Salt Lake City Board of Adjustment, and that on the 21st day of August, 1978, Case No. 7793 by Richard B. Sanborn was heard by the Board. Mr. Sanborn requested a variance on the property at 681 Third Avenue to construct a two-story addition to an existing nonconformingly located single-family dwelling without the required side yards in a Residential "R-6" District, the legal description of said property being as follows:

Commencing 3 rods east from the southwest corner of Lot 1, Block 15, Plat "D", Salt Lake City Survey, running East 37 feet; North 7 rods; West 37 feet; South 7 rods to the point of beginning.

It was moved, seconded and unanimously passed that this variance be granted, subject to approval from the Historical Landmarks Committee. If a permit has not been taken out in six months the variance will expire.
