his wife, Grantor S, for and in consideration of Five Hundred & No/100 Dollars, and other valuable consideration, receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, do hereby grant, bargain, sell, convey and warrant to UTAH POWER & LIGHT COMPANY, a corporation, Grantee, its successors and assigns, a perpetual easement and right of way for the construction, erection, operation and continued maintenance, repair, alteration, inspection, relocation, and/or replacement of a wood pole or steel tower line or lines for the transmission, distribution, telegraph and telephone circuits of the Grantee, and one tower ~~STRUCTURE~~ together with necessary cross-arms and attachments, with no guys including stubs and anchors, affixed thereto, for the support of said circuits, in, upon, along, over, through, across and under a tract of land 150 feet in width, situated in the County of Davis, State of Utah, particularly described as follows:

Beginning at a point 1739 feet East and S.  $36^{\circ} 41'$  E. a distance of 1034 feet from the NW corner of section 14, T. 4 N., R. 2 W., S.L.B. & M. and running thence S.  $36^{\circ} 41'$  E. a distance of 489 feet, more or less, thence North a distance of 251 feet, more or less, thence N.  $36^{\circ} 41'$  West a distance of 489 feet, more or less, thence South a distance of 251 feet, more or less, to the place of beginning, all in the NE  $1/4$  of the NW  $1/4$  of section 14, T. 4 N., R. 2 W., S.L.B. & M.
