

This indenture made this 20th day of March, 1936, between Monroe Hatch and Sarah C. Hatch, of Vernal, Uintah County, State of Utah, parties of the first part, and Vernal City, a municipal corporation of the State of Utah, party of the second part, WITNESSETH:

That the parties of the first part have granted unto the party of the second part for the consideration of One and no/100 (\$1.00) Dollar, receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, a right of way, for a water system pipe line across the premises owned by the parties of the first part, which said premises are described as follows, to-wit:

Beginning 59 rods South of the North Quarter corner of Section 35, Township 4 South, Range 21 East, Salt Lake Meridian, thence East 68 rods; South 315.5 feet; West 33 feet; South 20 feet; East 33 feet, South 26 rods and 11 feet; West 68 rods; North 43 rods to the place of beginning.

It is understood and agreed that the party of the second part will keep the said water system pipe line in good condition so far as not to damage said premises or interfere with the sale thereof.

QUIT-CLAIM DEED

Marvin F. Smith and Blanche Smith, his wife, grantors, of Wasatch County of Uintah, State of Utah, hereby Quit Claim to Uintah County, a Municipal Corporation, of Vernal, Utah, Grantee, for the sum of One Dollar and other valuable considerations, the following described tract of land in Uintah County, State of Utah:

Beginning 1620 feet North of Southwest (SW) corner of Section 8, Township 4 South, Range 21 East, S.L.M. thence East 30 feet, North 1020 feet, West 30 feet, South 1020 feet to beginning.

This deed is signed by the grantors conveying the said land to Uintah County to be used for road purposes providing that in case it is so used the said Uintah County will make irrigation ditch in lieu of one now used 1020 feet long 30 inches deep and 30 inches wide, re-build head gate same gutters and size as present one and furnish labor and build fence, materials for same to be furnished by said Uintah County.
