It being a tract of land fifty feet wide on each side of the center line of the Davis and Weber Counties Canal and its West Branch as the same is now located and operated across said land above described.

It is hereby understood that after the west branch and the north branch have decided, near the bottom of the hill, the right of way shall be twenty five feet instead of fifty feet on each side of the center line of said West Branch and said North Branch.
