Certificate No. 6072 TO ALL TO WHOM THESE PRESENTS SHALL COME, GREETING:

WHEREAS, there has been deposited in the GENERAL LAND OFFICE of the United States a CERTIFICATE OF THE REGISTER OF THE LAND OFFICE at Salt Lake City, Utah, whereby it appears that pursuant to the Act of Congress approved 20th May, 1862, "To secure

Homesteads to actual Settlers on the Public Domain" and the acts supplemental thereto, the claim of George Randall has been established and duly consummated, in conformity to law, for the Southeast quarter of the Northeast quarter, the North half of the Southeast quarter and the Northeast quarter of the Southwest quarter of Section Two in Township Two North of Range Seven East of the Salt Lake Meridian in Utah, containing one hundred and sixty acres, according to the official plat of the survey of the said land, returned to the GENERAL LAND OFFICE by the Surveyor General:

NOW KNOW YE, That there is, therefore, granted by the United States unto the said George Randall the tract of land above described: TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said tract of land, with the appurtenances thereof, unto the said George Randall, and to his heirs and assigns forever; subject to any vested and accrued water rights for mining, agricultural, manufacturing or other purposes, and rights to ditches and reservoirs used in connection with such water rights, as may be recognized and acknowledged by the local customs, laws and decisions of courts and also subject to the right of the proprietor of a vein or lode to extract and remove his ore therefrom, should the same be found to penetrate or intersect the premises hereby granted, as provided by law. And there is reserved from the lands hereby granted, a right of way thereon for ditches or canals constructed by the authority of the United States.

IN TESTIMONY WHEREOF I, William McKinley, President of the United States of America, have caused these letters to be made patent and the seal of the General Land Office to be hereunto affixed.

The Neff Live Stock Company, a corporation, organized and existing under the laws of the State of Utah, grantor, hereby convey and warrant to Wright Brothers Company, a corporation organized and existing under the laws of the State of Utah, Grantee, for the sum of Twenty Thousand (\$20,000.00) Dollars, the following described tracts of land in Summit County, State of Utah, to-wit:

The N $\frac{1}{2}$ of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$; the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$; the NE $\frac{1}{4}$; E $\frac{1}{2}$ of NW $\frac{1}{4}$; of Sec. 2 in T. 2 N.R. 7 E. containing 358.87 acres.

The E $\frac{1}{2}$ of Section 5; T. 2 N. R. 7 E., containing 320 acres.

Also commencing at a point which is nineteen chains S. from the NW. corner of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 5 T. 2 N.
