THIS DECLARATION, containing covenants, conditions and rederictions relating to the CANYON VIEW COMMINIUMS, Phase I is node on the date set forth at the end hereof by E.M.C. JOINT VENTURE, a Utah general patthership, hereinafter called "Declarate" for itself, its successors, grantees and assigns, pursuant to the Condominium Ownership Act of the State of Utah.

RECITALS

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Declarant is the owner of certain land located in Washington County, Utah, hereinafter referred to at the "land" and more particularly described at Exhibit A of this Declaration which is attached hereto and made a part hereof

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Declarant has constructed or will construct certain buildings and improvements thereon in accordance with the plans and drawings set forth in the Record of Survey Map filed concurrently herewith, prepared and certified Reid Pope, a Utah Registered Land Surveyor.

Declarant desires by filing this declaration and the fevord of Survey Map to submit the above-described real property and the said buildings and other improvements being constructed for to be constructed thereon, to the provisions of the Utah Condominium Ownership Act as a project known as the CANYON VIEW CONDOMINIUMS, Phase I.

ΙV

Declarant desires and intends to sell fee title to the individual Units contained in said projects together with undivided ownership interest in the Common Areas and Facilities apportenant thereto, to various purchasers, subject to the covenants limitations, and restrictions contained merein.

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Declarant desires and intends to develop the above project consisting of 38 units in Phase 1 and Common Areas (subject to addition as provided hereinafter).

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desires provide the reservation □ Declarant for embancement of property values and amenities of the Property and tokmaintenance of the Common Areas. To this end and for the benefit of the Property and of the Owners thereof the Declarant designs to subject the Property described above this Declaration to the covenants, restrictions, easements, charges, and liens hereinafter set forth, each and all of which are for the benefit of the Property and each Owner thereof.

DECLARATION

NOW, THEREFORE, for such purposes, Declarant hereby makes the following Declaration Containing covenants conditions and referrictions relating to this project which pursuant to the profisions of the Condon Nium Ownership Act of the State of Utah, 1981 be enforceable equitable servitudes, where reasonable, and shall run with the land:

- The name by which the Project shall Name of the Project: be known is the CANYON VIEW CONDOMINIUMS, Phase I.
- Definitions: The Merms used herein shall have the meaning stated in the Utah Condominium Ownership Act and as given in this section 2 unless the contest otherwise requires
- The words "The Act" shall mean and refer to the Wah condominium Ownership Act, Utah Code Annotated 1953, Section & 8-1, et. seq., as the same may be amended from time to time.
- (b) The words "Association of Unit Owners" of "Association" shall mean and refer to the CANYON VIEW OWNERS ASSOCIATION, a Utah nonprofit corporation, of which all of the Unit Owners are members. A copy of the Articles are attached hereto as Exhibit B. The Association shall be governed in accordance with the Articles, Declaration and By-Laws.
- The words "Common Areas and Facilities" shall mean and refer to:
- The land described in Exhibit "A" hereto and on (FF) the Record of Survey Map.
- That portion of the Property not specifically (2) included in the respective Units as herein defined.

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- (3) All foundations columns, girders beams, supports, mainwalls, roofs, stairways exterior walkways, streets, such recreational areas and facilities as may be provided, yards, fences, service and parking areas and entrances and exits, and in general all other apparatus, installations and other parts of the Property necessary or convenient to the existence, maintenance and safety of the Common Areas and Facilities or normally in common use;
- (4) Those Areas specifically get forth and designated in the Map as "Common Ownership" or "Limited Common Area"; and
- (5) All Common Areas and Facilities as defined in the Act, whether of not expressly listed herein.
- (d) The words "Common Expenses" shall mean and refer to all expenses of administration, maintenance, repair or replacement of the Common Areas and Facilities, except as expressly limited; to all items, things and sums described in the Act which are lawfully assessed against the Unit Coppers in accordance with the provisions of the Act, this Declaration, the By-Laws, such rules and regulations pertaining to the Project as the Association of Unit Common the Management Committee may from time to time adopt, and such the Committee may from time to time adopt, and such the Ranagement Committee.
- (e) The word "Condominium" shall mean and refer to the ownership of a single Unit in this Project together with an undivided interest in the Common Areas and Facilities of the Property.
- (f) The words Condominium Project or sometimes the "Project" shall mean and effer to the entire Coperty, including ble addition of future phases as defined below, together with all mants, obligations and organizations established by this Declaration.
- (g) The word "Declarant" shall mean E.M.C. Joint Venture, who has made and executed this Declaration, and/or its successor who, by either operation of law or through a voluntary conveyance, transfer or assignment, comes to stand in the same relation to the Project as did its predecessor.
- (h) The word "meclaration" shall mean this instrument by which the Canyon View Condominiums are established as a Condominium Project.
- (i) The words "Limited Common Areas and Facilities" or "Limited Common Areas" shall mean and refer to those Common Areas and Facilities designated herein or on the Map as reserved for use of a certain Unit to the exclusion of the other Units, including the patios, which are associated with certain Units, as shown on the Record of Survey Map.

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- (j) The words "Management Committee" or "Committee" shall mean and refer to the committee as provided in the Declaration and the By-Laws hereto attached as Exhibit C (which By-Laws are hereby incorporated by reference and made a part of this Declaration). Said Committee is charged with and shall have the responsibility and authority to make and to enforce all of the reasonable rules and regulations covering the operation and maintenance of the Project.
- The term "Manager" shall mean and refer to the person, persons or corporation selected by the Management Committee nanage the affairs of the Condominium Project.
- The word "Map" shall mean and refer to the Record of Survey Map of the CANYON VIEW CONDONINIUMS recorded concurrently herewith by Declarant.
- The word "Mortgage" shall mean and include both a (m) first mortgage on any Unit and a first deed of trust on any Unit.
- (n) The word "Nortgagee" shall mean and include both the mortgage on any Unit and the beneficiars under a first deed of Arust on any Unit.
- The word "Phase" shall mean and refer to each separate step in development of the property which is in thated through the subjussion of a tract to the terms of the Acts The term shall also include all improvements which are constructed and all appurtenances, rights, obligations, and legal relationships which come into existence in conjunction with the submission of any single tract. The submission which is effected by this Declaration, the rights and obligations which are created by this Declaration, and the Aprovements descripted in the Map which The been or will be constructed, together constitute a Phase.
- The word "Property" shall mean and include the Land, the building, all improvements and structures thereon, all easements, rights and appurtenances belonging thereto, and all articles of personal property intended for use in connection therewith. legal description of the property is set forth at Exhibit "A" hereto. The Property is subject to increase in subsequent Phases.
- (q) The word "Unit" shall mean and recent to one of the Communium Units designated as a Unit on Map. Mechanical echilpment and appurtenances located within any one Unit or located) without said Unit but designated and designed to serve only that Whit, such as appliances, electrical receptacles and outlets wir conditioning compressors and other conditioning apparatus, fixtures and the like, shall be considered part of the Unit, as shall all decorated interiors, all surfaces of interior seructural walls, floors and ceilings, windows and window frames,

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336719 doors and door fames, and trim, considering of, among other whings, and as appropriate, wallpaper, paint Flooring, carpeting and tile. All pipes, wires, conduits, or other public utility lines or instal-lations constituting a part of the Unit and serving only the Unit, and any structural members of any other property of any kind, including fixtures and appliances within any Unit, which are removable without jeopardizing the soundness, safety or usefulness of the remainder of the building within which the Unit is situated shall be considered part of the Unit.

- The words "Unit Number" shall mean and refer to The number, letter or combination thereof designating the Unit the Declaration and the Map.
- (s) "The words "Unit Owner" or "Owner" shall mean the person or persons owning a Unit of the CANYON VIEW CONDOMINIUMS in fee simple and an undivided interest in the fee simple estate of the Common Areas and Facilities as shown in the records of the County Recorder of Washington Courty, Utah. Notwithstanding any applicable the make relating to a more wage, deed of trust, war like instrument, the term Unit Owner or Owner shall not mean or include a mortgagee) or a beneficiary or crustee under a deed of trust unless and until such a party has acquired title pursuant to foreclosure or any arrangement or proceeding in lieu thereof.
- (t) Those definitions contained in the Act, to the extent they are applicable to and not inconsistent herewith, shall be and are hereby incorporated herein by reference and shall have the same effect as if expressly set forth herein and made a part hereof.
- Submission to Condominium Ownership Declarant hereby submits the above-described Property, track of land, buildings, constructed, together with all appurtenances thereto, to the provisions of the Access a Condominium Project and this Declaration is submitted in accordance with the terms and the provisions of the Act and shall be construed in accordance therewith. - 4. <u>Covenants to Run with the Land</u>. This Declaration containing covenants, conditions and restrictions relating to the Project shall be enforceable equitable servitude which shall run with the land and this peclaration and its pervitudes shall be bunding upon Declarant, its successors and a signs and upon all Units Owners or subsequent Unit Cwners, their grantees, mortgages, successors, heirs, executors, administrators, devisees and assigns.

Description of Property.

(a) Description of Land The land is that parcel in Washington County, Utah, more particularly described in Exhibit A hereto.

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Description of Improvements. The significant improvements contained or to be contained in the Project include those described in this paragraph (b). Rhase I of the Project Challes:

> 38 Units contained in 5 buildings as defined and described in the Map. The Units shall be of wood frame construction with asphalt shingle roofs, aluminium siding with brick accents. Phase I also includes a club house, tennis court, winming pool. All improvements are as defined and described in the Record of Survey Map.

The undivided interest of ownership of each condominion owner as provided about is subject to change if additional Phases are added as more willy set forth and described in the Declaration.

- (c) Description and Legal Status of Units. hereto shows the Unit Number of each Unit and the fraction of ownership interest appurtement to each. All Units, of whatever type shall be capable of Deing independently whed, encumbered and conveyed. The boundary lines of each Unit are the undecorated and or unfinished interior surfaces of its perimeter walls, bearing walls, lowermost floor, uppermost ceiling all window panes, doors, window frames and thor frames and trans Each Unit shall include both the portion of the building that are not common areas and facilities within such boundary lines and the space so encompassed. Without limitation, a Unit shall include any finishing material applied or affixed to the interior surfaces of the interior walls, floors, and ceilings, non-supporting interior walls and all utility pipes, lines, systems, fixtures, or appliances, found within the boundary lines of the unit and servicing only that unit. The actual physical boundaries of a Unit constructed or reconstructed substantially in accordance with the Map and Original plans shall be conclusively presumed to be its boundaries rather than the description expressed in the deed or plans, regardless of minor variance due to construction error, settling, and/or later move-
- (d) Common Areas and Recilities. Except as otherwise provided in the Declaration, the Common Areas and Facilities shall consist of the areas and facilities described in the definitions and constigute in general all of the parts of the Property except the Units Without limiting the generality of the Oregoing, the Common Aneas and Facilities shall include the following, whether located within the bounds of a Brit or not;
- (1) M1 structural parts of the buildings including, without limitation, foundations, columns, joints, beams, supports, supporting walks floors, ceilings and roofs;
- Parking areas (not designated as Limited Common Area), lawns, shrubs, and gardens, walkways;

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- (3) Thy utility pipe of Tine or system servicing more than a single Unit, and all ducts, wires, conduits, and other accessories used therewith;
- All other parts of the Property necessary or (4) convenient to its existence, maintenance and safety, or normally in common use, or which have been designated as Common Areas and Facilities in the Map:
- All Depairs and replacements of any of (5) Øregoing.
- Description of Limited Common Areas and Facilities. Each owner of a wift is hereby granted h irrevocable and exclusive license to use and occupy the limited common areas and the lities reserved exclusively for the use of his Unit. The limited common areas appurtenant to any given Unit consist of a patio assigned to each ground level Unit by Declarant. If parking is assigned by Declarant it shall be appurtenant to the Unit as a limited common area, But parking may be changed by reassignment approved by the Declarant provided that Che affected owners consent. The exclusive right to use and occupy each limited common area shall be appurtenant to and shall pass with the title to the Unit with which it is associated with respect to Phase Toll the project.
 - (f) Reservations Regarding Description of the Property.

ALL OF THE FOREGOING IS SUBJECT TO: all liens for current and assessments, and charges imposed or levied by taxes, quasi-governmental authorities: or all reservations and exclusions on mineral reservations of record and right incident thereto; an instruments of regold which affect the above-described land or any portion thereof including, without Amitation, any mortgage or deed of trust; and visible easements and Fights-of-way; all wasements and rights of way of records any easements, rights of way, encroachments or discrepancies otherwise existing; an easement for each and every pipe, line, cable, wire, utility line, or similar facility which traverses or partially occupies the above-described land at such time as construction of all Project improvements is complete; and all easements necessary for ingress to, egress from, maintenance of, and replacement of all such pipes, lines, cables wires, utility lines, and similar facilties.

ALL COMMON AND INNITED COMMON AREAS are subject to public ties and drainage casements for the installation and Otilities maintenance of improvements and such eastwents shall be subject to the right of the City of St. George to require the Canyon View Owners Association to assess its members to repair or replace public utilities located within the common of limited common areas.

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RESERVING UNTO DECLARANT, however such easements and rights of ess and egress over, across through, and under the e-described land and any improvements now or Pereafter ingress above-described land constructed thereon as may be reasonably necessary for the clarant or for any assignee or successor of Declarant (in a manner which is reasonable and not inconsistent with the provisions of this To construct and complete each of the Living Declaration): (i) Units and all of the other improvements as Declarant deems to be appropriate, and to do all things reasonably @essary or proper in connection therewith; (11) To construct and complete on the Phase I Land or any portion thereof such improvements as Declarant or Said assignee or successor shall determine to build in its sole (iii) To improve portions of the Property with such other or addictional improvements facilities, or landscaping designed for the use and enjoyment of all the Owners as teclarant or as such assignee or successor may reasonably determine to be appropriate. If, pursuant to the foregoing reservations, the above described land or any improvement thereon is traversed or partially occupied by a permanent improvement or utility line, a perpetual easement for such improvement or utility line shell exist. With the exception of such perpetual easements, the reservations hereby offected shall, unless sooner terminated in accordance with their terms, expire fire (5) years after the last supplementary Declaration is filled for record in the Office of the County Recorder of Washington County, Utah.

For the sax (6) years following the re-Alterations. cordation hereof, and for six years following the recordation of any expansion, the Declarant reserves the right to change the interior design and interior arrandement of any Unit and to alter the boundaries between Units to long as the Declarant owns the Units so aftered. Any such change shall be reflected by an amendment of this Declaration and of the Nap which may be executed by the Declarant Plone, notwithstanding the procedures for amendment described in Section 27 of this Peclaration. Such change may increase the number Units and After the boundaries of the Common Afters Facilities. In the boundaries between Units are altered or the number of Units increased, in the amendment related whereto, the Declarant shall reapportion the percentage of ownership in the Common Areas and Facilities which are allocated to the altered Units on the basis of the number of units.

Statement of Purpose and Restrictions on Use.

(a) Purpose. The purpose of the Project is to provide residential housing and parking space for Unit Owners and to tenants and guests, all the accordance with the provisions of the text. The units may be used for recreational housing and may be cented for this purpose on any basis allowable by applicable zoning

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- Restrictions on Use. The Units and Common Areas and (b) Facilities shall be used and occupied as hereinafter set fucth.
- (1) Each of the Units shall be occupied by the Unit Owner, his family, tenants, servants or guests as a private residence or a recreational condominium and for no other purpose, except for rights of ingrass and egress and rights to parking reserved to Declarant. Each driveway and parking area shall be used, by the Unit Owners, their families, servants or guests for the parking or storage of motor vehicles or such other items as the management Committee may approve and for no other purpose. No driveway or parking area shall be used for parking of trailers, mobile homes, motor homes, boats, or campers that have been statched from trucks unders otherwise allowed by the Rules and Regulations adopted by the Management Committee
- (2) Nothing shall be done or kept in any Unit or in the Common Areas and Facilities which will increase the rate of insurante on the building or contents the eof beyond that customarily applicable for residential use, will result in the cancellation of insurance on the buildings, or the contents thereof Unit Owner shall permit anything to be done or kept in his Unit or in the Common Areas and Facilities which is in violation of any law, ordinance or regulation of any governmental authority.
- No Unit Owner shall cause or permit whything (including, without limitation, a sign, awning, canopy, shutter, clothes line, radio or television antenna) to hang, he displayed or otherwise affixed to or placed on the exterior walls or roof or any part thereof, or on the Obside of windows or obors, without the prior written consent of the Management Committee.
- (4) · (4) noxious or offensive activity shall be carried on in any Opit or in the Comman Areas and Facilities, nor shall anything be done therein, either willfully or negligently, which may be or Decome an annoyance Or nuisance to the Ther Unit Owners or occupants.
- (5) Nothing shall be done in any Unit or in, on, or to the Common Areas and Facilities which will impair the structural integrally of the buildings or any part thereof or which would structurally change the buildings or any part wereof except as is otherwise provided herefin.
- (6) wanimals of any kind shall be raised, bred or kept in any Unit except that cats or giver quiet household gres may be kept in the Whit provided that they are not kept, bred or maintained for any commercial purpose or kept in unreasonable numbers. Notal this tanding the foregoing, no animals of low may be

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kept in the Project which result in a annoyance or are objectious, by noise or otherwise, to Unit owners in general dogs shall not be allowed unless approved in writing by the Declarant or the Management Committee may place conditions on such, including the right to cause the dog to be removed if the dog becomes an annoyance to other Lot owners. All pets must be kept in a fenced yard of the Unit of on a leash in the Common Areas.

- The Common Areas and Facilities shall be kept (7) free and clear of all rubbish, debris and other unsightly materials.
- (8) There shall be no comping or temporary residence or structure on the Common Area. No camping shall be allowed in any recreational or other vehicle parked in Common Area.
- Without the prior specific written permission of the Management Committee there shall be no use of the Common Area (a) which injures, erodes or scars said area or the vegetation thereon, or (b) which increases the cost of maintenance thereof, or (c) Which in any way alters the Common Areas or the location, color (design or materials of any Improvement visible from the Common Area The Common Area shall be used only by record Owners of a Condominium and dependents living with them, their benants, and a reasonable number of invited opens, as prescribed by the Management Committee. Each Owner shall be liable to the Association for any damage to the Common Area caused by him or his family, tenants or quests, which is not covered by insurance.
- (10) No admission fees, charges for use, leases or other income generating arrangement of any type shall be employed or entered into with respect to any portion of the Common Areas and Facilities, unless otherwise decided by the Management Committee.
- Person to Receive Service of Process. The person to receive service of process in the cases provided herein or in the Act is Milo McCowan, 260 W. St. George Blvd., St. George, Utah 84770. The said person may be changed by the recordation by the Management Committee of an appropriate instrument.

Ownership and Use.

- (a) Ownership of Unit. Except with respect to any of the Common Areas and Facily less located within the bounds of a unit. each Unit Owner shall be entitled to the exclusive ownership and possession of his Unit and to the ownership of an undivided interest In the Common Areas and Facilities in the fraction expressed in Exhibit D (subject to change as provided in this Declaration.
- (b) Wature of and Restrictions on Ownership and Use. Each Unit Owner shall have and enjoy the rights and privileges of

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fee simple ownership of his Unit. There shall be no requirements concerning who may own Units, it being intended that they may and shall be owned as any other property rights by persons, corporations, partnerships, or trusts and in the form of common tenancy. The Unit Owners may lease or rent their Units with their appurtenant rights subject to terms and conditions chosen solely by the Unit Owner and his lessee, except that all Unit Owners, their tenants and other occupants or users of the project shall be subject to the Act, this Declaration, the By Daws, and all rules are regulations of the Association of Unit Owners and Management Committee.

- (c) Prohibition Against Subdivision of Unit. No Unit Owner, except Declarant pursuant to Paragraph 6, by deed plat or otherwise, shall subdivide or in any manner cause the ownership of his Unit to be separated into physical tracts or parcels smaller than the whole Unit as shown on the Map and no driveway, parking area or other limited common area which is incident to any Unit shall be conveyed separately from such Unit. There shall be no timesharing of a unit without the express permission of the Declarant, which permission may be withheld in the sole discretion of the Declarant.
- Areas and Facilities contained in the Project are described and identified in Section 5(d) of this Deplaration. Said Common Areas and Facilities shall be owned by the Unit Owners as tenants in common. No percentage of undivided ownership interest by the Common Areas and Facilities shall be separated from the Unit to which it appertains; and even though not specifically mentioned in the instrument of transfer, such a percentage of undivided ownership interest shall automatically accompany the transfer of the Unit to which it relates. The Common Areas and Facilities shall be used only in a manner which is consistent with their community nature and the use restrictions applicable to the Units contained in the Project.
- (e) The of Common Areas and Facilities. Except with respect to Limited Common areas each Unit Owner may use the Common Areas and Facilities in accordance with the purposes for which they are intended, but subject to this Declaration and the By-Laws. This right of use shall be appurtenant to and run with each Unit.
- Owner's exclusive right of use and occupancy of the Limited Common Areas and Facilities. A Unit of use and occupancy of the Limited Common Areas and Facilities reserved for their Unit shall be subject to and in accordance with this Declaration and the By-Laws. Any Limited Common Area shall be leased only to persons who reside in the Project or used by the family, serounts or guests thereof on a temporary basis.

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Members and Voting Rights.

- (a) Membership. Every conter shall be a Member of the Association. Membership in the Association shall be mandatory, shall be appurtenant to the unit in which the owner has the necessary interest, and shall not be separated from the unit to which it appurtains.
- Voting Rights. The Association shall have following described two classes of voting membership.
- Class A. Class A Members shall be all the owners other than the Declarant. Class A Members shall be entitled to one vote for each unto in which the interest required for memebraship in the Association is held. In no event, however, shall more than one Class A vote exist with respect to any unit.
- Class B. The Class B Member shall be the Declarant. The Class B Member shall be entitled to three (3) votes for each unit (Whether or not completed) in which it (holds the interest required for membership in the Association. The Class B membership shall automatically cease and be converted to Class A membership of the first to occur afathe following events:
- (a) When the total number of votes held by all Class A members Chials the total number of votes held by the class B Member:
- The expiration of five (5) years after the (b) date on which this Declaration is filed for record in the office of the County Recorder of Washington County, Utah.
- (c) Changes to Voting Procedure Subject to the five wear limitation above it Declarant shall exercise his option to additional units the at such time as the mended or supplementary Declaration is fixed the voting shall be adjusted accordingly, including that Declarant may regain his Class B voting status for all units owned (whether of not completed), even if previously converted to was A status under the terms hereof.
- (d) Voting-Multiple Ownership. The vote attributable to and exercisable in connection with a Unit shall be the percentage of undivided ownership interest in the Common Areas and Facilities which is appurtenant to such Unit. In the even there is more than one where of a particular whit, the vote relating to such Unit shalf be exercised as such owners may determine among themselves by Owners shall be conclusively presumed to be the vote attributable to the Unit concerned unless an objection is immediately made by another Owner the same Unit. In the event such an objection is

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made, the vote involved shall not be counted for any purpose watsoever other than to determine whether a quorum exists.

12. Management.

- (a) Management Committee. The business, property and affairs of the Project shall be managed, operated and maintained by the Management Committee of the Association as agent for the Unit Owners. The Management committee shall have, and is hereby granted the following authority and powers:
- (1) The authority, without the vote or consent of the Unit Owners of any other persons, to grant or create, on such terms as it deems advisable, willity and similar assements, over, under, across and through the Common Areas and Facilities; and work performed pursuant to such easements must be done in a workmanlike manner and any damage to the interior structure or decor of a Unit must be repaired;
- (2) The authority to execute and record, on behalf of Unit Owners, any amendment to the Decoration or Map which has been approved by the vote or consent necessary to authorize such amendment;
- (3) The authority to enter into contracts which in any way concern the Project, so long as any vote or consent of the Unit Owners necessitated by the subject matter of the agreement has been obtained:
- (4) The power and authority to convey or transfer any interest in real property, so long as any vote or consent necessary under the circumstances has been obtained;
- (5) The power and authority to purchase, otherwise acquire, and accept to the to, any interest in real property, so long as such action has been authorized by any vote or consent which is necessary under the circumstances;
- (6) The power and Authority to add any interest in real property obtained pursuant to paragraph (5) above to the Project, so long as such action has been authorized by the necessary vote or consent;
- (7) The anthority to promagate such reasonable rules, regulations, and procedures as may be necessary or desirable aid the Committee in carrying out any of its functions of to insure that the project is maintained and used in a manual consistent with the interests of the Unit owners; and
 - (8) The power and authority to perform any other

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acts and to enter the any of the transactions which may be transonably necessary for the Management Commuttee to perform its Tunctions as agent for the Unit Owners, including but not limited to the power to sue and be sued.

(9) The Association and any aggrieved Unit Owner shall be granted a right of action against Unit Owners for failure to comply with the provisions of the Declaration, By-Laws, or equivalent documents, or with decisions of the Association which are made pursuant to authority granted the Association documents. Unit Owners shall have similar rights of action against The Association.

Any instrument executed by the Management Committee that recites facts which, if true, would establish the Committee's power and authority to accomplish through such instrument that is purported to be accomplished thereby, shall conclusively establish said power and authority in favor of any person who in good faith and for value relies upon said instrument.

Composition of Management Committee. (b) The Committee shall be composed of five (5) members. At the first regular Associ-Ation meeting two (20) Committee members Andll be elected for threeyear terms, two (2) Committee members while be elected for two-year terms and one (X) Committee member for a one-year term At each annual Association meeting thereafter any vacant seat on the Committee shall be filled with a member elected for a three year term. Only Unit Owners and officers and agents of Owners other than individuals shall be eligible for Committee membership. At the annual meeting the percentage of undivided ownership interest appurement to a Unit may be voted in favor of as many candidates. for committee membership as there are seats on the Committee to be filted; provided, however, that until the annual Owners meeting to be held in November of each year, (hereinafter referred to as the Event"), Declarant alone shall be entitled to select three (3) of the first (5) Committee members. Notwithstanding the foregoing limitations, until the firm annual meeting of the Owners, the members of the Committee, although numbering less Wan five (5) shall be the following persons and each shall hold the office indicated opposite his name:

Each Unit Owner will, accordingly, pay and discharge any and all taxes which may be assessed against his Condominium Unit.

Insurance.

- (a) <u>Hazard Insurance</u>. The Nanagement Committee or Association of Unit Owners shall at all times maintain in Corce Insurance. hazard insurance meeting the following requirements:
- A multi-peril type insurance policy shall be maintained, covering the entire Project (both Units and Common areas and Facilities), including fixtures, to the extent they are part of

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the common elements of the project, building service equipment and supplies, and other common personal property belonging to the Association. Such policy shall provide coverage against loss or damage by fixe and other hazards overed by the standard extended coverage endorsement, debris removal, cost of demolition, vandalism, malicious mischief, windstorm, water damage, and such other risks as cutomarily are covered with respect to condominium projects similar to the Project in construction, location, and age. As a minimum, such policy shall provide boverage on a replacement cost basis in an amount not less than that necessary to comply with any co-insurance percentage specified in the policy, but not less than one hundred percent (100%) of the full insurable wathe (based upon replacement cost). Such polycy shall include an Mareed Amount Endorsement" or its equivalent @ "Demolition Endorsement" or its equivalent, and if necessary or appropriate, an "Increased Cost of Construction Endorsement" or its equivalent, and a "Contingent Liability from Operation of Building Laws Endorsement" or its equivalent.

- (2) If the project is or comes to be situated in a locate identified by the secretary of Housing and Urban Development as an area having special flood hazards and the sale of flood insurance has been made available under the National Flood Insurance Act of 1968, a "blanket" policy of flood Insurance on the Project shall be obtained and maintained. Association of Unit Owners shall at all times maintain in force a comprehensive policy of public liability asurance covering all of the Common Areas and Facilities. The limits of liability under such insurance shall not be less than \$1,000,000 for all claims for personal injury and or property damage arising out of a stoole occurrence. occurrence.
- (d) Ceneral Requirements Concerning Insurance. insurance policy or fidelity bond maintained pursuant to the foregoing Sections 18(a) through 18(c) shall be written by an insurance carrier which is licensed to transact business in the State of Utah and which has a financial rating by Dest's Insurance Reports of Class or better. If due to changed circumstances, excessive cost or any other reason, by of the insurance coverage required to be obtained and maintained under Sections 184a) through 18(c) hereof cannot reasonably be secured, with respect to such coverage the association or the committee shall obtain and maintain such substitute, different or other coverage as may be reasonable and prudent under the irrumstances as the then exist.

- (e) The following additional provisions shall apply with respect to insurance:
- (1) In addition to the insurance described above, the Committee shall secure and at all times maintain insurance against such risks as are or hereafter may be customarily insured against in connection with condominium projects similar to the Project in construction, nature, and use.

 - (6) Any Unit Owner may obtain additional insurance at his own expense, so long as such additional insurance does not have the effect of decreasing the amount which may be realized under any policy maintained by the Committee. Any Unit Owner who individually obtains insurance covering any portion of the Project shall supply the Committee with a copy of his policy within thing (30) days after he acquires such insurance.
 - **₩(7)** Notwithstanding anything herein contained to the contrary, insurance coverages must be in such amounts and meet other requirements of the Federal National Mortgage Association.
 - The Board Shall periodically, Review of Insurance. (f) and whenever requested by twenty percent (201) or more of the owners, review the adequacy of the Association's insurance program and shall report in whiting the conclusions and action taken on such review to the owner of each unit and to the holder of any mortgage on any unit who stall have requested a copy of such report. Copies of every policy of insurance procured by the Board Shall be available for inspection by the owner.
 - Unacceptable Policies. Policies are unacceptable where: (i) under the terms of the carrier's charter, by-laws or policy contributions or assessments may be made against the unit mortgagee or mortgagee's designer from collecting insurance proceeds.
 - Power (h) Insurance <u>Trustees: Power of Attorney.</u>
 Notwithstanding of the foregoing provisions and requirements relating to property or liability insurance, there may be maked as an insured, on behalf of the Association, the Association's authorized representative, including any trustee with thom such Association may enter into any Insurance Trust Agreement or any successor to such trustee (each of whom shall be referred to herein as the "Insurance Trustee") who shall have exclusive authority to negotiate losses under the policy providing such property or liability insurance and to perform such officer functions as are ecessary to accomplish this purpose.

Payment & Expenses.

(a) Peclarant hereby coverants to, and each Owner shall, by acceptance of a deed to a Condoninium whether from Developer or a

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subsequent owner of such Condominium bind himself, him heirs, personal representatives and assigns to pay all assessments and charges determined and levied by the Association upon each Condominium owned by him, including interest thereon and collection costs thereof, if any, including attorneys' fees. The obligation to pay such assessments, charges, interest and costs cannot be waived or avoided by nonuse of the Common Area or abandonment or transfer & of a condominium, and constitutes a personal obligation and coverant running with the land. The grantee of a volunta The grantee of a voluntary conveyance of a Condominium, except as provided in the Mortgagee rotection Articles these Restrictions is jointly and severally liable with the grantor for all unpaid assessments which accrued against the Condominium prior to the Time of conveyance and which are described ar a statement from the Association to sech grantee prior to conveyance of the Condominium.

- (b) Declarant shall establish a working capital fund for the initial months of the project operations equal to at least a two-months' estimated charge for each unit.
- (c) Each Unit Own . shall pay the Management Committee the Management Committee to manage and operate the Project, upon the terms, at the time, and in the manner herein provided without any deduction on account of any set-off or claim which the Owner may have against the Management Committee, Declarant, or Association. Each installment shall be due on or before the first day of each month. If the Unit Owner shall fail to pay any installment within five (5) days of the time when the same becomes due, the Owner shall pay a 5% late fee and interest thereon at the rate of eighteen percent (18%) per annum from the date when such installment shall become due to the date of the payment thereof, together with a costs and expenses, including attorney fees, incurred in any proceedings brought to collect such unpass common expenses.
- The cash requirements above referred to for each year, or portuins of the year, are hereby defined and shall be deemed to be such aggregate sum as the Management Committee from time to time shall determine, in its judgment, is to be paid by all the Gwners of the Project then in existence to enable the Management Committee to pay all estimated expenses and outlays of the Management committee to the close of such year, growing out of or in commercial with the major mance and operation of such land, builted ings and improvements; which sum may include, among other things, the cost of management, special assessments, fire, casualty, wood, fidelity, public Cability and other Chaurance or bond premiums, common lighting, landscaping, and the care of the grounds Pepairs, and renovations to Common Areas and Pacilities, and other services which are separately billed or metered to the individual Units by the utility or party furnishing such service, legal and accounting

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fees, management (fees, expenses and (febilities incurred (fees) Management Committee under or by reason of this Declaration, the payment of any deficit remaining from the previous period, the creation of creasonable contingency or other necessary reserve or surplus fund, as well as all other costs and expenses relating to the Project. The Management Committee may, from time to time, up to the close of the year for which such cash requirements have been so fixed or determined, increase or diminish the amount previously fixed or determined for such year. It may include in the cash requirements for any year, any liabilities or items of expense which Recrued or became payable in the previous wear, or which might have been included therein; and also any sums which the Management Committee may deen necessary or prudent to provide a reserve against liabilities or expenses then accrued or thereafter to accrue although not payable in that year.

- (e) The portion payable with respect to each Unit in and for each year or for a portion of a year shall be a sum equal to the aggregate amount of such cash requirements for such year, or portion of wear, determined as afficesaid, multiplied by the percentage of undivided interest in the Common areas and Facilities appurtenant to such Unit, as shown in Exhibit D, except as hereinafter provided. Such assessments, together with any additional sums accruing under this Declaration (shall be payable monthly in advance, or in such payments and installments as shall provided by the Management Committee. Provided, however, Destarant's obligation for common expenses (which shall not include reserves for future expenditures) may be limited to subsidization of the association, under such subsidy agreement as may be negotiated by the Association and approved by applicable regulatory authority, but in no event more than the amount payable it beclarant were required to pay a full assessment on unsold and sampleted units.
- The Management Committee Ball have discretionary powers to prescribe the manner of maintaining and operation the Project and to determine the cash requirements of the Kanagement Committee to be paid as aforesaid by the Owners under this Declaration. Every such reasonable determination by the Wanagement Committee within the bounds of the Act, and this Declaration shall be final and conclusive as to the Owners, and all expenditures made by the Management Committee, within the bounds of the Act and this Declaration shall as against the Owner be decided necessary and property made for such purpose.
- If an owner shall at any time let or sublet his whit and shall default for a period of one mouth in the payment of any assessments, the wanagement Committee may, at its option, so long as such default shall continue, demand and receive from any Cenant or subtenant of the Owner occupying the Unit the rent due of becoming due and payment of such rent to the Management Committee shall be

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- (h) Each monthly assessment and each special assessment shall be separate, distinct and personal obligations of the Owner(s) of the Unit against which the same is assessed at the time the assessment is made and shall be collectible as such. Suit to recoxer a money judgment for unpaid common experies may be maintained without foreclosing ow waiving the following lien securing the the amount of any assessment, whether regular or special, assessed to a Unit plus interest at eighteen percent (18%) per annum, and costs, including reasonable actorney's fees, shall become a lien upon such unit upon recordation of a notice of assessment as provided by the Act. The said ten for nonpayment of common expenses shall have priority over all other liens and entumbrances, recorded or unrecorded, except only:

Unless a withen request for a certificate of indebted mess shall be complied with within ten (10) working days, all unpaid common expenses which became due prior to the date of making of such request shall be subordinate to the Wien or interest held by or obtained by the person making the reguest. Any encumbrance holding a lien on a that may pay any unpaka Common Expenses payable with respect to such Unit and upon such payment such encumbrance shall have a lien on such Unit for the amounts paid of the same rank as the lien of his encumbrance.

- (3) To abandon, partition subdivide, encumber sell transfer all any part of the common Areas and Racilities (except for the granting of easements for utilities and similar purposes consistent with the intended use of the Common Areas and except as provided in Section 16 hereof in the event of certain destruction or damage);
- To use dazard insurance proceeds resulting from (4) damage to any part of the project (whether to Hits or to the Common Areas) for purposes other than the repair, replacement, or reconstruction of such improvements, except as provided in Section 16 mereof in the event of certain destruction or damage;
- To change the prograta interests or obligations of any Unit which apply for (a) purposes of levying assessments or charges or allocating distributions of hazard insurance proceeds or condemnation awards and for (b) determining the pro rata share of ownership of each Unit in the Common Areas and Facilities, (except as allowed in the case of expansion at Section 350.

- In the event another provision or clause of this Declaration deals with the same subject matter as is dealt with in any provision or clause of this Section, the provision or clause which results in the greatest protection and security for a Mortgage shall control the rights, obligations, or limits of authority as the case may be, applicable to the management Committee and Association of Unit Owners with respect to the subject concerned.
- No amendment to this Section which has the effect of diminishing the rights, protection or security afforded to Mortgagees shall be accomplished or effective unless all of the Mortgagees of the individual Units have given their prior written approval to such amendment. Any amendment to this Section shall be accomplished by an instrument executed by the Management Committee and filed for record in the office of the Washington County Recorder. In any such instrument an office of the Management Committee shall certify that any prior written approval of Nortgagees required by this Section as a condition to amendment has Deen obtained.

Notwithstanding any other provision contained herein, until the sale of all units in the project including additional phases as may be added: no amendment to the Map or to any provision of this Declaration which has or may have the effect of diminishing or impairing any right, power, authority, privilege, protection or control accorded to Declarant in his capacity as declarant) herein which such amendment is effective unless the instrument through which such amendment is purported to be accomplished is consented to in writing by Notwithstanding anything in this Declaration to the contrary, no mendment to this Declaration which has the effect of the rights, protection or security afforded diminishing Mortgagees shall be accomplished or effected unless all of the Mortgagees of the individual Units have given their prior written mortgagees of the amendment
- In any case in which the Act or Consent in Lieu of Vote. this Declaration requires the vote of a stated percentage of the Project's undivided whership interest for authorization or approval of a transaction, such requirement may be fully satisfied by obtaining, with or without a meeting consents in writing to such transaction from Unit Owners who collectively hold at least the stated percentage of undivided ownership interest. The following additional provisions shall govern any application of this section:

- (g) There shall be no limitations as to the location of any improvements that may be made on any portions of the additional land edded to the condominum project; accordingly, no assurances are made in that regard
- (h) The maximum number of units that may be created on the additional land shall be 38. The maximum number of units per acre that may to created on any such portion added to the condominium project shall be 24.

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- (i) The maximum percentage of the aggregate land and floor area of all units that may be created on Phase II, the use of which will not Or may not be restricted exclusively to residential purposes is the intention of the Declarant that this project be limited to residential purposes only.

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BYLAWS

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CANYON VIEW OWNERS ASSOCIATION

L IDENTITY

These are the By-Laws of the Canyon View Owners Association doly made and provided for in accordance with the Utah Condominium ownership Act. Any term used herein which is defined in the Declaration to which the By-Laws are appended shall have the meaning ascribed therein.

II. APPLICATION

- 1. Place of Meetings. Meetings of the Association shall be held at such place within the State of Utah as the Management Committee may specify in the notice, except as herein otherwise specified.
- 2. Annual Meetings. The first annual meeting of the association shall be held at the Project in November, 1988. Thereafter, the annual meetings shall be held on such day weach succeeding year; provided, however, that whenever such date falls on a legal holiday, the meeting shall be held on the next succeeding business day, and further provided that the Management Committee may by resolution fix the date of the annual meeting on such date or at such other place as the Management Committee may deem appropriate.
- Special Meetings. Special meetings of the Association may be called at any time by the Management Committee or by Unit Owners who collectively hold at least forty percent (40 %) of the total wate. Such meeting shall be held on the Project or such other place as the Management Committee may specify and the notice thereof shall state the date, time and matter to be considered.
- 4. Notices. Written or printed notice stating the place, day and hour of all meetings of the Association and, in case of a special meeting, the purpose or purposes for which the meeting is called, shall be delivered not less than ten (10) days before the date of the meeting, either personally or by mail to each Unit Owner. If mailed, such notice shall be deemed to be delivered when deposited in the United States mail addressed to the member at his address as it appears on the records of the Association, with the stage thereon preparation.
- 5. Quorum. At the meeting of the Association, those owners present at such meeting shall constitute a quorum for any and all

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purposes, except where express provisions of these By-Laws or the Declaration of Condominium require a voite of a specified percentage of the Association membership, in which event a quorum shall be the percentage of the interest required for such vote. In the absence of a quorum, the chairman of the meeting may adjourn the meeting from time to time, without notice other than by announcement at the meeting until holders of the amount of interest requisite to constitute a quorum shall attend. At any such adjournment meeting at which a quorum shall be present any business may be transacted which might have been transacted at the meeting as originally motified.

- Voting. When a quorum is present at any meeting, the vote of the Unit Owners representing more than fifty percent (50%) of the undivided interest present at the meeting either in person or represented by proxy, shall decide any question of business brought before such meeting, including the election of the Management Committee unless the question is one upon which by express provision of the Declaration of these By-Laws, a greater vote is required, in which case such express provision shall govern and control the decision of such question. All votes may be cast either in person or by proxy. All proxies shall be in writing, and in the case of proxies for the annual meeting, they shall be delivered to the secretary at least five (5) days prior to said annual meeting.

 Proxies for special Unit Owners' meetings must be of record with the secretary at least two days prior to said special meeting.
- Waivers of Notice. Any Unit Owner may at any time waive any notice required to be given under these By-Laws, or by statute or otherwise. The presence of Unit Owner in person at any meeting of the whit Owners shall be deemed such waiver.

MANAGEMENT COMMITTEE

- Purpose of Fowers. The business property and affairs of Project shall be managed and governed by the Management Committee, which for purposes of the Utan Nonprofit Corporation and Cooperative Association Act shall be the same as the "Governing Board" as used in said Act.
- The Management Committee shall be elected as Election. provided in the Declaration.
- Vacancies. Vacancies on the Management Committee shall be filled as provided in the Declaration.
- Regular Meetings. A regular annual meeting of the Management Committee shall be held immediately after the adjournment of each annual meeting of the Unit Owners Regular meetings wher than the annual meeting, shall or may be held at regular intervals

- Special Meetings. Special meetings of the Management Committee shall be held whenever called by the president, vice president, or by two or more members. By unanimous consent of the Management Committee, special meetings may be held without call or notice at any time or place.
- Quorum. A quorum for the transaction of business at any meeting of the Management Committee shall consist of a majority of the members of the Management Committee them in office.
- 7. Compensation. Members of the Management Committee as such, shall not receive any stated salary or compensation; provided that nothing herein contained shall be construed to preclude any member of the Management Committee from serving the Project in any other capacity and receiving compensation therefore.
- Waiver of Notice Before or at any meeting of the Management Committee, any member thereof, may, in writing, waive metice of such meeting and such waiver shall be deemed equivalent to the giving of such notice. Attendance by a member of the Management Committee at any meating thereof shall be a waiver of notice by him of the time and pace thereof.
- Adjournments. The Management Committee may adjourn any meeting from day to day or for such other time as may be prudent or necessary, provided that no meeting may be adjourned for longer than thirty (30) days.

OFFICERS

- 1. Designation and Election. The principal officers of the Management Committee shall be a president, and a The principal officers of the secretary/treasurer all of whom shall be elected by and from the Management Committee. The Management Committee may appoint assistant secretary and an assistance treasurer and such other officers as in their judgment may be necessary or desirable. election or appointment shall regularly take place at the first meeting of the Management Committee immediately following the annual meeting of the Unit Owners: provided, however, the elections of officers may be held at any other meeting of the Management Committee.
- The Management Commuttee may appoint such Other Offices. other officers, in addition to the officers hereinabove expressive named, as they shall deem necessary, who shall have authority to perform such duties as may be prescribed from time to time by the Management Committee.

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- All officers and agents Removal of Officers and Agents. shall be subject to removal, with or without cause, at any time by the affirmative vote of the majority of the then members of the Management Committee.
 - The president shall be the chief executive of President. the Management Committee, and shall exercise general supervision wer its property and affairs. He shall sign on behalf of the Project all conveyances, mortgages and contracts of material importance to its business, and shall do and perform all acts and things which the Management Committee may be equire of him. He shall preside at all meetings of the Unit Owners and the Management Committee. He shall have all of the general powers and duties which are normally vested in the office of the president of a corporation, including, but not limited to, the power to appoint committees from among the members (or otherwise) from time to time as he may in his discretion decide is appropriate to assist in the Conduct of the affairs of the Project.
 - Vice President The vice president shell take the place of the president and perform his duties whenever the president shall be absent or unable to act. If neither the president nor the vice president is able to act, the Management Committee shall appoint some other member thereof to do so on an interim basis. The wice president shall also perform such other duties as shall from time to time be prescribed by the Management Committee.
 - The secretary shall keep the minutes of all Secretary. meetings of the Management Committee and of the Unit Owners; he shall have charge of the books and papers as the Management Committee may direct; and he shall in general, perform all the duties incident to the Office of secretary.
 - Treasurer. The treasurer shall have the responsibility for the funds and securities of the Management Committee and shall be responsible for Reeping full and accurate accounts of all receipts of all disbursements in books belonging to the Management Committee.
