ABSTRACT OF DECISION

I, Marilyn E. Young, being first duly sworn, depose and say that I am the secretary of the Salt Lake County Board of Adjustment, and that on the 29th day of November, 1979, Application #79-103-B, submitted by Max K. & Norma P. Mangum was heard by the Board. Max K. & Norma P. Mangum requested a variance for a reduction in area from 20 acres to 20,000 square feet, in an FR-20 Zone, on the separate parcels of land described below. By motion seconded and carried the Board of Adjustment unanimously approved this application for a variance for a reduction in area from 20 acres to 20,000 square feet, for each parcel of land, subject to the site plan on file and being restricted to a single family dwelling.

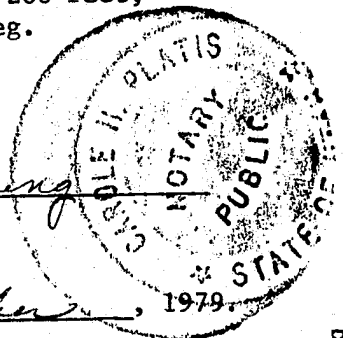
Parcel #1

Beginning South 65 deg. 19' East 200 feet from Corner No. 1 (Northwest Corner) of Dickinson Lode Mining Claim designated by United States Surveyor General as Lot No. 4715 in Section 35 Township 2 South, Range 3 East, Salt Lake Meridian and running thence 65 deg. 19' East 100 feet; thence 11 deg. 45' West 200 feet; thence North 65 deg. 19' West 100 feet; thence North 11 deg. 45' East 200 feet to point of beginning.
