Deed of Right of Way.

Carrie Johnson and a widow her wife, of Union, Salt Lake Co, Utah grant for the sum of Three dollars, hereby convey and warrants to Murray City, a municipal corporation, of the State of Utah, its successors and assigns, grant a Right of Way for transmission lines, consisting of poles or other supports and wires, for the transmission of electrical power, over and across the property hereinafter described, and the right to construct, operate and perpetually maintain, said transmission line, over and across the following described property, in Salt Lake County, State of Utah,

Beginning at a point thirteen (13) chains thirty (30) links north from the S. W. corner of Section 20 in Township Two S. Range 1 E. Salt Lake Meridian, and running thence N. on Section line 26.8 rods, thence E. S. 2 Rods; Thence South 26.8; Thence South 26.8 rods; Thence West 3.2 rods to point of beginning.

Said transmission line shall be constructed, and maintained substantially along the following line: About five ft. ~~ft.~~ West from the East Boundary line of said tract of land, as now surveyed by said city.

Together with the right to enter upon said premises along the route of said transmission line for the purpose of erecting the poles and transmission lines, and thereafter to enter upon said lines, when necessary for the purpose of maintaining, inspecting, repairing, and reconstructing the same. Upon the conditions, however that the said City, its successors and assigns, shall pay to the said grantor her heirs, successors and assigns, any and all damages that may be, at any time, occasioned, by the owner of said line, its agents or servants, to the growing crops or premises of the party of the first part, her successors and assigns while engaged in the construction, reconstruction, inspections or repairing of said poles or said transmission line.
