Deed of Right of Way:

L. E. Forbush and Katherine Forbush his wife, of Union Utah, grantors for the sum of One (\$1.00) dollars hereby convey and warrant to Murray City, a municipal corporation, of the State of Utah its successors and assigns grantee a Right-Of-Way for a transmission line, consisting of poles or other supports and wires, for the transmission of electrical power, over and across the property hereinafter described, and the right to construct, operate and perpetually maintain, said transmission line, over and across the following described property, in Salt Lake County, State of Utah,

That property owned by grantors and located in the <sup>of the S. W. 1/4</sup> S. W. 7 Sec. 20, T 2 S. R 1 E. S. L. 3 + M.

Said transmission line shall be constructed and maintained substantially along the following line: about 70 ft East of west line section 20, T 2 S R 1 E, S L. 3 + M, and running in a westerly Direction as located and staked on the ground, across grantors property at this location.

Together with the right to enter upon said premises along the route of said transmission line for the purpose of erecting the poles and transmission line, and thereafter to enter upon said line, when necessary for the purpose of maintaining, inspecting, repairing, and reconstructing the same.

Upon the conditions, however that the said City, its successors and assigns, shall pay to the said grantors their heirs, successors and assigns, any and all damages that may be at any time occasioned, by the owner of said line, its agents or servants, to the growing crops or premises of the party of the first part, their successors and assigns, while engaged in the construction reconstruction, inspec-

tion, or repairs of said poles or said transmission line.
