

Deed Of Right Of Way

Mary J. Loring of Monroe, Utah grantor for the sum of (\$6.00) Six Dollars, hereby conveys and warrants to
Murray City, a municipal corporation, of the state of Utah, its successors and assigns, Grantee a Right of Way
for a transmission line, consisting of poles, or other supports and wires, for the transmission of electrical
power, over and across the property herein described, and the right to construct, operate and perpetually
maintain said transmission line, over and across the following described property in Salt Lake County, State
of Utah.

The East $\frac{1}{4}$ of the S. W. $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec 34 T 2 R 18 S. L. B + m.

The said transmission line shall be constructed and maintained substantially along the following line.

Bearing approx. N 54° W across the center portion of grantor's property as surveyed and staked out on
the ground.

Together with the right to enter upon said premises along the route of said transmission line, for the
purpose of erecting, the poles and transmission line, and thereafter to enter upon the said line when nec-
essary for the purpose of maintaining, inspecting, repairing and reconstructing the same.

Upon conditions, however, that the said City, its successors and assigns, shall pay to the said grantor, her
heirs or successors, and assigns any and all damages that may be at any time occasioned by the owner
of the said line, its agents or servants, to the growing crops or premises of the — grantor, her successors
and assigns, while engaged in the construction, reconstruction, inspection, or repairing of said poles, or said
transmission line.


