ABSTRACT OF FINDINGS AND ORDER

I, Mildred G. Snider, being first duly sworn, depose and say that I am the Secretary of the Salt Lake City Board of Adjustment (414 City & County Buildings), and that on the 21st day of July, 1980, Case No. 8372 by John S. Adams was heard by the Board. Mr. Adams requested a variance on the property at 953 Third Avenue to legalize a driveway approach installed by the City which does not lead to a legal parking area in a Residential "R-2" District, the legal description of said property being as follows:

Commencing at the Southwest corner of Lot 2, Block 27, Plat "G", Salt Lake City Survey, running thence East $46\frac{1}{2}$ feet; thence North 127 feet; thence West $46\frac{1}{2}$ feet; thence South 127 feet to the point of beginning.

It was moved, seconded and unanimously passed, since the problem can be solved without requiring a variance and make the property more usable, that the requested variance be denied.
