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ABSTRACT OF FINDINGS AND ORDER


I, Mildred G. Snider, being first duly sworn, depose and say that I am the Secretary of the Salt Lake City Board of Adjustment (414 City & County Building), and that on the 29th day of September, 1980, Case No. 8445 by John S. Adams was heard by the Board. Mr. Adams requested a variance on the property at 953 Third Avenue (the northeast corner of Third Avenue and "P" Street) to erect a fence which would exceed the permitted height in a Residential "R-2" District, the legal description of said property being as follows:

Commencing at the Southwest corner of Lot 2, Block 27, Plat "G", Salt Lake City Survey, running thence East 46½ feet; thence North 127 feet; thence West 46½ feet; thence South 127 feet to the point of beginning.

It was moved, seconded and unanimously passed that a variance be granted to allow a 6' fence because of the grading problem and the fence was moved to meet the requirements of a previous variance; this is approved subject to a favorable recommendation from the Historical Landmark Committee. If a permit has not been taken out in six months the variance will expire.
