RESOLUTION

A RESOLUTION TO ESTABLISH THE EAST MILLARD RECREATION DISTRICT AND TO AUTHORIZE CONSTRUCTION OF IMPROVEMENTS AS SET FORTH IN THE REVISED NOTICE OF INTENTION TO CREATE THE DISTRICT.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Chairman and Board of Commissioners of Millard County, Utah:

Section 1. The Board of Commissioners of Millard County, Utah, believe that the public health, convenience and necessity require the construction of the improvements identified and described in the revised Notice of Intention concerning the establishment of the East Millard Recreation District.

Section 2. The Municipalities of Scipio, Holden, Fillmore, Meadow and Kanosh have each been presented with a certified copy of the resolution adopted by the Board of County Commissioners on June 6, 1979, and have consented to the inclusion of each such respective Municipality within the District.

Section 3. The Board of Commissioners has heretofore considered each and every protest filed and has heard each and every person who wished to be heard in protest against the creation of the District or the construction of any of the improvements therein or on any other matter pertinent to said Special Service District.

Section 4. The construction of a swimming pool facility proposed and described in the revised Notice of Intention to create said Special Service District of Millard County, Utah, are hereby authorized, and East Millard Recreation District is hereby created.

Section 5. The Board of County Commissioners will receive and consider further written protests against the improvements therein for fifteen days following this meeting or until 5:00 p.m. on August 16, 1979. The creation of said District pursuant to the adoption of this resolution shall remain in effect unless the Board determines as of its first regular meeting after August 16, 1979, that more than 50% of the qualified voters within the boundaries of the District oppose creation of said District. In that event, the Commission shall again meet in regular session to reaffirm the establishment of the District, modify the boundaries or purposes of the District, or rescind this resolution creating the District.
