Party Wall Agreement.

This Agreement, made in duplicate this 31st day of July, A.D. 1915, by and between Charles W. Symms and Verae A. Symms, his wife, Guy B. Symms, unmarried, and Effie C. Symms, first parties, and E. F. Hanna and Anna M. Hanna, his wife, second parties, Witnesseth:

Whereas, the parties hereto are severally seized of adjoining parcels of land in lot 6, Block 61, Plat A, Salt Lake City Survey, and

Whereas, the parties hereto have heretofore constructed and erected a party wall upon the following described premises, situated in said lot 6, in Salt Lake City and County, State of Utah, to-wit:

Commencing at a point on the North line of said lot 6, 41 feet, 3 inches ^{East} of the Northwest corner of said lot 6, Block 61, Plat "A", Salt Lake City Survey, running thence West 1 foot, thence South 100 feet, thence East 1 foot, thence South 38 feet, more or less to the South end of said wall, thence East 2 feet, thence North 38 feet, more or less, to a point 100 feet South of the North line of said lot, thence West 1 foot, thence North 100 feet, to the North line of said lot, thence West 1 foot to the place of beginning, and.

Whereas, the wall erected upon said described premises was constructed at the joint expense of the parties hereto with the understanding and agreement that the same was to be and remain a party wall, and Whereas, the parties are desirous of reducing their agreement to writing and eviden-

citing the same ~~hereby~~ by the record thereof,

Now, Therefore, the parties hereto do hereby, in consideration of the premises and of the sum of one dollar each to the other paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, covenant and agree, each with the other:

First, that said wall shall be and remain a party wall; Second, that either party may, in case of damage to said wall, repair the same, or in case of the destruction of said wall, rebuild the same, using good materials and workmanship and conforming to the building laws and ordinances, and in case of repairs or upon the rebuilding of said wall, one-half of ^{the cost of} said repairs or said rebuilt wall shall be paid to the party making the same by the owner of the other parcel on demand;

Third, Either party hereto may, add to said wall in height, using good materials and workmanship and conforming to the building laws and ordinances, and when said addition to said wall is used by the owner of the other parcel, he shall pay the owner of the other parcel, on demand, one-half of the cost and expense of constructing said addition to said wall.

Fourth, the agreements herein contained shall apply to, and enure to the benefit of and be binding upon the heirs, successors and assigns of each of the parties hereto, as if so specifically expressed throughout, and shall be covenants running with the land; but the rights, duties and obligations herein of each party and of his heir or their heirs, successors or assigns, shall cease with the termination of his or their ownership in said respective parcels of land, except the duties and obligations growing out of or arising during such ownership, and one-half of the reasonable expense incurred by either of the parties hereto, for the benefit and use of the parcel of land of the other party, as herein provided, shall be a lien upon the parcel for whose benefit and use the same was incurred, until paid.
