Right-Of-Way Deed

Utah Power & Light Company, a corporation of the State of Maine, doing business in the
State of Utah, and Utah Light And Traction Company, a corporation of the State of Utah, grantors,
herew quit-claim to Salt Lake County, grantee, for the sum of One (\$1.00) Dollar, a perpetual
Right-of-way over and across the following described tract of land in Salt Lake County, State of
Utah:

A strip of land 40.0 feet wide being 20.0 feet wide on each side of the center line of
said right-of-way, said center line of right-of-way being more particularly described as follows:
to-wit:

Beginning on the East side of Grantors' property 151.3 feet south of the northeast corner
of Sec. 25 of Twp. 2 S. R. 1 East of the S.L.B. & M. and running thence westerly on a 40 degree
curve to the right 53.6 feet, thence southerly on a 52 degree curve to the left 134.5 feet,
thence southerly on a 60 degree curve to the left 150.0 feet, thence south 55 degrees 02 minutes
east on a tangent 100.0 feet, thence southerly on a 90 degree curve to the right 205.0 feet,
thence north 50 degree 32 minutes west on a tangent 43.4 feet, thence northwesterly on a 30 degree
curve to the right 113.3 feet, thence north 16 degrees 32 minutes west on a tangent 200.0 feet to
the intersection of another right-of-way containing 0.92 acres.

It is the intention of Grantors to donate said right-of-way to said Salt Lake County for the
use of the public as a highway, subject, however, to the terms of a mortgage given by the Utah
Light and Traction Company to the Banker's Trust Company of New York as trustees, under date of
September 18th, 1914; and to the terms of a mortgage given by the Utah Power & Light Company to
Guaranty Trust Company of New York and William C. Cox as trustees, under date of February 2nd,
1914.
