## ABSTRACT OF FINDINGS AND ORDER

I, Mildred G. Snider, being first duly sworn, depose and say that I am the Secretary of the Salt Lake City Board of Adjustment (414 City & County Building), and that on the 3rd day of August, 1981, Case No. 8706 by Clifton H. Jolley was heard by the Board. Mr. Jolley requested a variance on the property at 1010 Third Avenue to erect an addition to an existing nonconformingly located single-family dwelling without the required side yards in a Residential "R-2" District, the legal description of said property being as follows:

Commencing 75 feet East from the Northwest corner of Lot 3, Block 21, Plat "G", Salt Lake City Survey, running East 45 feet; South 125 feet; West 45 feet; North 125 feet to the point of beginning.

It was moved, seconded and unanimously passed that a variance be granted to construct an addition which will follow the existing lines of the home, provided the petitioner receives a favorable recommendation from the Historical Landmark Committee. If a permit has not been taken out in six months the variance will expire.
