## Q U I T C L A T M R E E P.

Irvin H. Jacob, Grantor, of Provo City, Utah County, State of Utah, hereby quit-claims to Utah Consolidated Oil Company, a corporation of the State of Utah, Grantee, for the sum of One Dollar and other good considerations, the herein described interest in the following described tracts of land in Utah County, State of Utah, to-wit:

The perpetual right to extract and dispose of any and all kinds of oil, oil products, oil rocks, or other sources of oil or any products produced in connection with oil; together with right of ingress, and egress to and from the land; namely, Section 2, Township 6 South, Range 1 West, Salt Lake Meridian, containing 640 Acres.

Subject to a mortgage given by the grantor to the State of Utah, for the sum of Four Thousand (\$4000.00) Dollars.

The grantor retains the further right to renew said mortgage or to give other mortgages on said land not to exceed in amount a total of Five Thousand (\$5000.00) Dollars, and any such mortgage given by the grantor not exceeding said last named sum shall take precedence in right over the grant above specified to said grantee.


The grantor retains all rights to use said land and the whole thereof not inconsistent with or interfering with the rights herein granted.
