Newhouse Park Company, a corporation, organized and existing under and by virtue of the laws of the State of Utah, Grantor, of Salt Lake City, County of Salt Lake, State of Utah, hereby conveys and warrants to Bonneville On The Hill Company, a corporation, organized and existing under and by virtue of the laws of the State of Utah, Grantee, of Salt Lake City, County of Salt Lake, State of Utah, for the sum of Ten (\$10) Dollars and other valuable considerations, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, the following described real estate, situate, lying and being in the County of Salt Lake and State of Utah, to-wit :

A The Northwest Quarter of the Southeast Quarter, the Northeast Quarter of the Southwest Quarter, the Northwest fractional Quarter of the Southwest fractional Quarter and the North half of the Southeast Quarter of the Southwest fractional Quarter, and the North fractional half of the Southwest fractional Quarter of the Southwest fractional Quarter of Section Thirty-three(33), in Township One (1) North of Range One (1) East of Salt Lake Meridian (as per patent recorded in Book 2-"E" at page 108 of the records in the office of the Recorder of said Salt Lake County); Also
