Garfield Water Company, a corporation doing business in the State of Utah, hereby conveys and warrants to Utah Power & Light Company, a corporation, its successors in interest and assigns, Grantee, for the sum of One (\$1.00) Dollar and other valuable consideration, a perpetual easement and right of way for the erection and continued maintenance, repair, alteration, and replacement of the electric transmission, distribution and telephone circuits of the Grantee, and 2 towers and 4 poles, with the necessary guys, stubs, cross-arms and other attachments thereon, or affixed thereto, for the support of said circuits, to be erected and maintained upon and across the premises of the Grantor, in Salt Lake County, Utah, along a line described as follows: A strip of land 140 feet in width commencing on the North boundary of Grantor's land 142 feet East of the West 1/4 corner Sec. 21, T. 1 S., R. 2 W., S. L. M.; thence running S. 10° 36' W. 10 feet; thence S. 50° 07' W. 110 feet; thence S. 89° 38' W. 25 feet to East boundary of Road; thence S. 140 feet; thence N. 89° 38' E. 60 feet; thence N. 50° 07' E. 215 feet; thence N. 10° 36' E. 72 feet to North boundary of S. The rights hereby granted are subject to the condition that, should the said poles or towers, or either of them, of the grantee, interfere with any operations of the grantor, or its allied interests, Utah Copper Company, Bingham, etc.

Garfield Railroad Company, Garfield Smelting Company, or the American Smelting & Refining Company, then the grantee will, at the cost of the grantor, or any one of said allied interests at whose request such change is made, readjust its wires to avoid such interference, or will remove any such poles or towers and attachments thereon to any other feasible point upon the premises of the grantor to be designated by the owner thereof.

Together with all rights of ingress and egress necessary or convenient for the full and complete use, occupation and enjoyment of the easement hereby granted, and all rights and privileges incident thereto, including the right to cut and remove timber, trees, brush, overhanging branches and other obstructions which may injure or interfere with the Grantee's use, occupation or enjoyment of this easement.

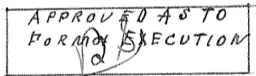
